Requirements for the DPGA Scholarship Award

Preferential consideration will be given to candidates who:

- a. Are in financial need
- b. Are active golfers
- c. Are majoring in or taking courses in a field related to golf, agronomy or agriculture

Each candidate must submit a portfolio that includes:

1. A completed application (with current photo)
2. A copy of last years income tax return
3. A high school transcript
4. A letter of recommendation from a DPGA golf professional or a DPGA representative. If not a member of a DPGA club, a letter can be written by golf coach or golf pro
5. A letter of admission to an accredited college or university
6. Photo copy of applicants handicap
7. Must be available for an in person interview with the Scholarship committee in June

The DPGA Scholarship is renewable as long as the student maintains a 2.5 grade average. Selection of a scholarship recipient is determined through a majority vote by the Board of Directors following a personal interview with each candidate. Scholarships are awarded to deserving students regardless of sex, race religion, or national origin.
