Judging sheets **MUST** be on the correct color of paper for each judging day:

PINK for March 1, Piano Levels 1 through 3

BLUE for March 8, Piano Levels 4 through 10

PASTEL PURPLE for Voice on March 8

Please fill in all the blanks.

Type or print **VERY** clearly. Make sure all your information is correct. These are the forms students will put in their school files, and they are the forms judges will see.

Do not write student's name on the judging sheet. Attach name to the sheet by paper clip or "post-it." **Do not staple!**

Your Performance Judging Sheets are due February 6, 2009.

Piano Repertoire: For Level 4 students and above, make sure that each student is playing one piece from each of the following periods:

1. Baroque
2. Classical
3. Romantic or Modern

Note: to be "from a musical period" the composer must have lived during that period. For instance, a Sonatina in classical style written by a romantic or modern era composer is still a Romantic or Modern piece. The MTNA Composer Classification List can provide some assistance with this.

Level 7 students who wish to go on to Semi-Finals **must** play a Classical piece in sonata-allegro form.
