2009 SEMI-FINALS INFORMATION

Semi-finals date: April 18, 2009

Deadline for applications *for all levels*: March 16, 2009

1. **Eligibility:** All students who have 90 or more points, with 67 or more points in performance, and who meet the level requirements as stated on pages 4-7 of the SAT Handbook, are eligible to participate in the State Semi-Finals. You will receive the necessary application forms and performance sheets which are also available on LAPTF's web site (<http://home.comcast.net/~DianaMunch>) There is a \$20 entry fee per student.
2. Fill out **two** Performance Rating Sheets and **one** application form per student.
3. Enter the names of students who are eligible and wish to participate on the Application for Semi-Finals Auditions form. Students must compete in their own District.
4. Send:
  - a) Applications (one per student)
  - b) Performance Rating Sheets (two per student)
  - c) **One** check made out to **Evelyn Evon-Callow**.
5. **No applications will be accepted after March 16, 2009.**  
The East Division Semi-Finals Chairman will not accept individual applications; you **must** mail your applications to our chapter semi-finals chairman,  
**Evelyn Evon-Callow, 31410 Orchard Creek, Farmington Hills, MI 48334-1314.**
6. To make sure your applications are in on time, we suggest that you have them in the mail by March 13, 2009 for all levels.
7. You must provide help if you send students to semi-finals:  
2-5 students – work ½ day. 6 or more students – work the full day.  
*Your helper may be the teacher or a representative.*
8. Students entering the Semi-Finals audition are expected to perform at the State Finals if selected. **“If a student fails to fulfill his responsibility to play at State Student Day (Finals), s/he shall be ineligible to compete in Semi-Finals the following year.”** (MMTA Board ruling)
9. Students need to provide **ONE copy** of their music for Semi-Finals and Finals judges.
