Congratulations to students for their participation in the recent Student Achievement Testing program.

Students deserve recognition by their schools for this effort and accomplishment. Copies of the MMTA Rating Sheet giving the judge's comments and scores along with a copy of the MMTA Certificate of Achievement can be placed in the student's school file. Parents are entitled to request that the MMTA SAT results be placed in the student's CA-60 file, a cumulative file containing academic and non-academic information for each student K-12. High school students can request that the MMTA SAT results be placed in their portfolio. This privilege was granted to high school students by Bill #4572 passed by the Michigan legislature. The school counselor is suggested as a contact person.

You are urged to have a record of your child's Student Achievement Testing results placed in the school file. A record of music study is beneficial when applying for employment or college admission. It is recognized that experience in the arts teaches skills that can be transferred to the workplace and can improve the student's ability to learn.

School recognition gives significance to the Student Achievement Testing experience.
