Kitsap Keepers is pleased to make a profound commitment in the development of District 3 and District 4 soccer players. We organize, administer, and provide for a full range of training needs for goalkeepers and advanced and/or supplemental training for field players at an economical price.

Kitsap Keepers will attend the matches of our goalkeepers and trainee teams when possible (with priority given to older players/teams), provide verbal (or sometimes written) assessments of performance to players and their coaches, provide any requested coaching education courses, advocacy for our trainees (and the club) when necessary, and evaluations at tryouts if requested by the team coach or program coordinator.

#### NKSC SPONSORED GOALKEEPING SERVICES

2008 group goalkeeping services for NKSC will be communicated to program goalkeepers by NKSC then initiated through a NKSC registration (\$40 [NK Select] or \$20 [Rec – late summer] per goalkeeper) through the [NKSC online store "Training" section](#). This registration, which is subsidized by NKSC, entitles players to a Kitsap Keeper affiliate membership and age/skill appropriate group training throughout 2008 as follows:

- All-inclusive and in-depth small group goalkeeper training for goalkeepers U12 and above.
- Groups will be determined by the Kitsap Keeper Staff, which align with player's age and skill level: Basic, Intermediate & Advanced.
- Technical fundamentals instruction includes: hand and body position, diving, jumping, ball clearing (hands and feet).
- Tactical fundamental instruction includes: field position, team communication, organizing the defense, transition play, defending against dead balls & set plays.
- Observation, assessment and critique of post-match performance.

#### INDIVIDUAL GOALKEEPING SERVICES

Players/parents may contract directly with Kitsap Keepers to provide individualized goalkeeper training similar to above. Individual sessions are \$17.00 per player per session, and are limited to two individual sessions per player per year. We only invite players for individual training when there is a specific individual need that we believe requires attention. During these sessions Kitsap Keepers does not provide any training that is not directly related to goalkeeping.

## FIELD PLAYER SERVICES

Teams may contract directly with Kitsap Keepers for field player services. Fee is a flat \$40 per session (not per player). Multiple session clinics/camps are billed directly to the team accordingly. The best way to receive services for Field Players is for the coach to discuss his/her team requirements with Kitsap Keeper Staff so sessions or clinics can be tailored to team needs as required. Observation of a team at a match/scrimmage by Kitsap Keepers and corresponding recommendation can help coaches decide training most appropriate.

- Small group (6 – 8) training sessions for field players U-14 and above. Addressing:
  - Individual and small group possession, attacking and scoring
  - Individual and small group defending

All sessions can be customized to fit the developmental needs of the individual players and / or the group, and can be organized as a single session, a series of sessions (clinic), or a residential camp.

- Team training sessions, clinics, or camps for U-14 and above. Addressing:
  - 5 vs. 5 through 11 vs. 11 to progressively improve large group possession build up, systems and styles of play, group and team defending, defending and attacking from a set plays.
- Formal and informal evaluations and/or recommendations to coaches or individuals following team clinics or camps. Please specify.
- Coaching clinics which are free or at a nominal charge.

Kitsap Keepers is committed to providing excellent training at a reasonable cost. Further, we will offer training to any committed goalkeeper or team regardless of their financial situation. Our training is unconditionally guaranteed: all money will be refunded from any session if you are not completely satisfied for any reason. I have attached a copy of my soccer resume to this document.
