Louisiana/Mississippi Blending Conference

The churches in Louisiana and Mississippi announce the semi-annual blending conference at Percy Quin State Park near McComb, Mississippi, on **October 30 – November 1, 2009**.

The first meeting of the conference will begin at 7:00pm on Friday.

Dinner will be provided at 6:00pm at the conference center, just before the first meeting.

An on-site registration counter will be open on Friday at 5:00pm, but, **registering by email ahead of time is extremely helpful in determining dormitory and cafeteria requirements.**

Note that there is a registration fee, which encompasses: (1) the park entrance fee, (2) the conference center use fee, (3) lodging in the Group Huts/Dormitory for two nights and (4) all meals during the conference (six meals are included beginning Friday evening).

Bring your own pillow, sheets, blankets (or sleeping bag), and toiletries.

The motel rooms will be reserved by request for those with physical needs and families with small children. The cost for the onsite motel is in addition to the normal registration fee.

FELLOWSHIP AND SCHOLARSHIPS

It is our hope that all who desire to come to the conference would be able to come regardless of ability to make the donation. Scholarships are available but must be requested prior to the conference. This need must be fellowshipped with the responsible ones in your locality prior to arriving at the conference center.

CHILDREN'S SERVICE AND REGISTRATION

Children's meetings will be held concurrently with the conference meetings in a separate room as in previous years. All children attending the conference must also register. Children who stay in the group huts or dormitory and take a tray at the cafeteria must pay the registration fee. Small children who share a bed and meal with their parents are not required to register.
