

Troop 240 Philmont Equipment Check List

All participants are to be in complete travel uniform to and from Philmont. Below is an equipment checklist divided into four sections. The intent is that once your pack is filled, it not be opened until we arrive at Philmont. All travel items should be contained in the travel bag except your sleeping bag and pad. **This list is all-inclusive. You may bring more gear but you must have all items on the checklist.**

Equipment Worn or Packed for Travel:

- ___ ___ 1 Scout Uniform (shirt, shorts, socks, boots, and belt)
- ___ ___ 1 pair hiking boots
- ___ ___ 1 contingent backpack (issued June 14)
- ___ ___ contingent gear (hat, 2 shirt, neckerchief given the day we leave)
- ___ ___ 2 underwear shorts
- ___ ___ 2 t-shirts
- ___ ___ 2 shorts or swim suit
- ___ ___ 1 pair of water shoes or old sneakers for rafting
- ___ ___ 1 large Towel
- ___ ___ 1 1 quart water bottle (filled)
- ___ ___ \$100-\$200 for souvenirs

Equipment for Travel and Trail:

- ___ ___ pillow (optional)
- ___ ___ 1 flashlight (small, with extra batteries)
- ___ ___ 1 toilet kit (comb, soap, toothbrush and paste, toilet paper)
- ___ ___ 1 jacket
- ___ ___ 1 pair of sneakers for camp (other pair may not be dry)
- ___ ___ 1 first aid kit (moleskin, suntan lotion, foot powder, etc.)
- ___ ___ other hygiene products
- ___ ___ 1 small sewing kit (optional)
- ___ ___ camera & film (optional)
- ___ ___ 1 poncho or rain gear
- ___ ___ 3 bandannas (use as rags also)
- ___ ___ 1 sleeping bag rated to 20 deg. (not packed in travel bag)
- ___ ___ 1 sleeping pad (not packed in travel bag)

Equipment Worn or Packed for Trail:

- ___ ___ 1 pack frame w/hip belt
- ___ ___ 2-3 1 quart water bottle (packed filled)
- ___ ___ 1 pr long pants (used for spar pole climbing)
- ___ ___ 1 pair hiking shorts
- ___ ___ 1 pair camp shorts
- ___ ___ 2 underwear shorts
- ___ ___ 1 wool shirt or sweater
- ___ ___ 2 t-shirts
- ___ ___ 3 pair wool socks
- ___ ___ 3 pair polypropylene sock liners
- ___ ___ 1 pair camp socks
- ___ ___ 1 wide brim hat (baseball cap does not protect ears from sun)
- ___ ___ 1 mess kit (cup, bowl and spoon)
- ___ ___ 1 pack cover

- ___ ___ 1 knit cap
- ___ ___ 1 Day pack or fanny pack (for side hikes)
- ___ ___ 1 set of sleep clothes (pack in sleeping bag)
- ___ ___ 1 set of long underwear
- ___ ___ 1 pocket knife (small)
- ___ ___ 1 leather boot lace
- ___ ___ 1 compass
- ___ ___ 50 feet parachute cord
- ___ ___ 4-8 zip lock bags assorted size at least one 30-gallon size (keeps gear dry and organized)
- ___ ___ 1 butane lighter or matches
- ___ ___ Marker, pen & paper
- ___ ___ \$10 for drinks
- ___ ___ Whistle

Equipment Packed for Crew:

- ___ ___ 4 Tents
- ___ ___ 4 Ground cloth for tent
- ___ ___ 8 Tent stakes (each person)
- ___ ___ 3 Stoves
- ___ ___ 3 Fuel Bottles (empty and aired out)
- ___ ___ 1 Troop Flag
- ___ ___ 1 Philmont Fly
- ___ ___ 1 Philmont Fly poles
- ___ ___ 1 Philmont Fly ground cloth
- ___ ___ 1 Large first aid kit
- ___ ___ 1 Crew water bottle with duct tape (filled for cooking) (each person)
- ___ ___ 1 Camp shovel to dig latrine
- ___ ___ 1 Crew Plastic trash bags (each person)
- ___ ___ 2 Bottles Camp Suds soap
- ___ ___ 12 Scrub pads

From Philmont

- ___ ___ Trail Chef cook kit - 8 qt pot, 4 qt. pot w/ lid, 1 fry pan w/ handle
- ___ ___ 1 extra 8 qt pot for washing dishes
- ___ ___ Trail Chef cutlery kit - 2 large spoons, 1 large spatula
- ___ ___ 2 pair hot-pot tongs
- ___ ___ Water purification chemicals
- ___ ___ 150' of 1/4" nylon rope (2.5 lbs.)
- ___ ___ 3 bear bags for hanging food (1/2 lb. each)
- ___ ___ Plastic strainer and rubber scraper (1/2 lb. total)
- ___ ___ Toilet paper

Regarding the double places for check marks; use one column when you assemble the gear, the other when it is placed in the pack or bag. **(double check everything).**

There will be the last crew meeting on June 14 to hand out crew gear and our agenda. Also we can iron out last minute problems at that time.

A departure Mass will be celebrated at St. Vincent's on June 21 at 7 PM. All participants must attend in summer class "A" uniforms. Troop members, family, and friends of the participants are encouraged to join us.
