Augusto Boal (Theatre of the Oppressed) and J. L. Moreno (Sociometry and Psychodrama) each applied improvisational theatre in family and community situations. Several of their techniques will be taught and practiced including role reversal, doubling, Image Theatre, and Forum Theatre. In developing theatres of social healing it is clear that the practice of seeing inter-personal situations from multiple points of view enhances mutual respect, collaboration, and social justice. We will develop theatres for social healing that participants may use in their own professional and community settings.

Lee, PhD, Licensed Psychologist, is formerly Executive Producer at WGBH and on the faculty of the Harvard Medical School at the Cambridge Hospital and the University of Massachusetts in Boston. He now consults to the Program on Negotiation, Harvard University, and co-leads actionmethods.org, the Action Methods and Video Feedback Interest Group at the Family Institute of Cambridge, MA.

Jody Scheier, LICSW, consults to the Family Center in Somerville and is on the faculty of Gerontology Summer Institute at Boston University, and the Harvard University Program on Negotiation.
