Dan Hall knew music would be his life's passion when, as a small child, he was transfixed by the Beatles' first televised performance on the Ed Sullivan Show in early 1964. Growing up in Union, New Jersey, he studied piano until age 12, when his musical direction was changed forever by the discovery of his dad's old 1940s archtop guitar in the basement. In the live-music heyday of the early 1970s, he fronted bands that performed regularly at dances and other teen venues around North Jersey. This was when he first encountered the Asbury Park music scene, which became the foundation of his rock and roll personality and gave focus to a new passion: songwriting.

From there to Memphis, Dallas, Virginia and back, he continued to hone his songwriting and guitar skills, and his exposure to the dominant musical genres in his new geography (blues, country, bluegrass, Rockabilly and Texas swing) added texture to his distinctive songs and singing style that define him today.

Now a popular performer in Monmouth and Ocean County, Dan is a versatile musician and singer/songwriter, comfortable playing solo acoustic shows, as half of a duo, or backed by a band.

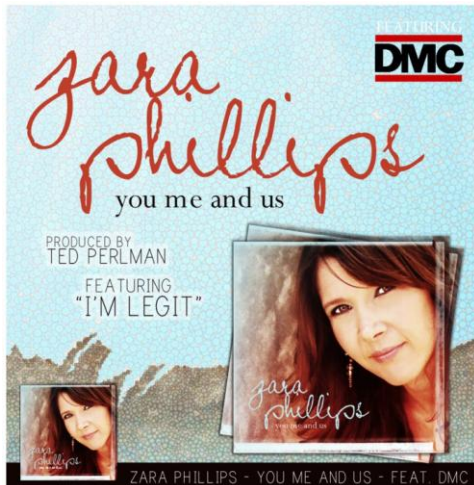
Cook Smith
