AmigaOne X1000 To Ship by Year's End; Amiga Netbook Announced

Big news from the Amiga world this weekend. That stubborn bunch are holding AmiWest 2011 this weekend, and it's been one heck of an eventful little, uh, event. Not only will the AmigaOne X1000 start shipping by year's end, Hyperion also announced something many in the Amiga world have been waiting for for a long time: an Amiga laptop.

Update: Steven Solie, AmigaOS' team lead, also held a presentation about the past, present, and future of AmigaOS. The team is working on some pretty interesting stuff - protected address space, multicore support, USB3, new printing subsystem, and much more.

Portable Amiga in the works

and portable Amiga is getting prepared for launch. According to a statement made by a spokesperson of AmigaOS developer Hyperion Entertainment <http://hyperion-entertainment.biz/>, the portable Amiga - for the moment referred to as a "netbook" computer - is already running AmigaOS <http://www.amigaos.net/> in a yet-to-be-disclosed version. Also mentioned is a release date of the first half of 2012.

Supposedly, the new netbook Amiga is/will be "sourced in a special configuration from an OEM". The OEM http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Original_equipment_manufacturer in question is, just like the price tag, the launch date, and the hardware specifications, currently unknown which is paving the way for further speculation and rumors.

The netbook Amiga will set a mark in computer history as the first portable Amiga to see the light of the day since the Amiga 1000 http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Amiga_1000 was introduced to the US market in 1985.

The "First Contact" system comprises a fully equipped AmigaOne X1000 complete with the official "Boing Ball" case and

AmigaOS4.1 Update 5 pre-installed. It is also supplied with a license for AmigaOS4.2 which can be downloaded when it is released by Hyperion Entertainment.

Matthew Leaman of AmigaKit said "As part of our ongoing commitment to the Amiga community we are delighted to be able to offer the AmigaOne X1000 to our customers. Based on current manufacturing schedules we hope to have the first systems ready for Christmas and New Year delivery."

A-EON Technology director Trevor Dickinson added "It's been a long and at times a difficult journey, but we are pleased that the Amiga community will finally have access to this exciting new hardware for the AmigaOS4."

The "First Contact" system includes the official AmigaOne X1000 "Boing Ball" case in either black or white and includes the Nemo rev 2.1 motherboard complete with 1GB of DDR2 RAM, a Radeon HD4650 graphics card, 500GB HDD, DVR R/W optical drive, Audio and Ethernet cards. Prices start from: £1699 (excluding AmigaOS4 license, shipping, handling and sales tax). Optional extras include the "Boing Ball" keyboard and mouse, Ram, HDD, and Optical drive. Upgrade options plus Debian Squeeze pre-installed in a dual booting configuration with AmigaOS4. Please refer to the special A1-X1000 system configurator on the AmigaKit website for pricing and upgrade options. All orders will be processed on a first come first served bases.
