_____ **RELATIONSHIP OF MUSIC STUDY TO BRAIN DEVELOPMENT** **Chp. Mickey Young.** This is the most active and ongoing committee in ASBDA. This committee presented its fifth edition of this study at the 1999 convention and is working on the sixth edition this year.
