








90h x 90w over one thread
 roughly 3.6" per side on 25ct
 roughly 3.25" per side on 28ct
 roughly 2.8" per side on 32ct
 model 1: 25ct cream Lugana with gold flecks
 model 2: 28ct forget-me-not blue Jobelan

tree roots: Kloster blocks in tree trunk colors
 tree branches: cross stitch over two in varied colors
 inner roots: needleweaving and dove's eyes
 one strand #12 perle cotton Anchor color #388
 leaves: one strand Emerald Wildflowers #65
 16 leaves per tree; distribute colors
 border: one strand Twilight Wildflowers #24
 straight and diagonal mosaic stitch

 is a Kloster block
  is a straight mosaic stitch
 is needle-weaving
  is a diagonal mosaic stitch
 is a dove's eye
 is a leaf with your needle coming up at odd numbers shown and going down 2 holes down and 2 holes left for 1, 3, 5, & 7 1 hole down and left for 9 & 11; down at base for 13
 Caron Impressions for tree trunks and Kloster blocks
 ● 1110 chocolate brown (81 stitches plus Klosters)
 ○ 1112 mahogany brown (81 stitches plus Klosters)
