

Mexican Pizza Dip

Yield: 8 Servings

8 Ounce Cream Cheese, Room -Temperature	-Drained
10 Tablespoon Tomato Paste, Small -Can	2 Cups Shredded Mexican Cheese, -Set Aside
12 Teaspoon Taco Seasoning, 1 -Package	1 Pounds Mild Italian Sausage, -Cooked And Drained
1 Pounds Ground Beef, Cooked And	4 Ounces Sliced Pepperoni, Chopped

Preheat oven to 350 degrees.

This entire recipe is done in layers:

- 1) Spread cream cheese on a greased 9 x 13 baking sheet. This is the bottom layer.
- 2) Spread entire small can of tomato paste on the cream cheese.
- 3) Sprinkle one half the taco seasoning packet on the tomato paste.
- 4) Layer the ground beef.
- 5) Sprinkle the other half of the taco seasoning packet on the ground beef.
- 6) 1/3 the cheese next.
- 7) Layer the italian sausage.
- 8) Second layer of 1/3 cheese.
- 9) Layer the chopped pepperoni.
- 10) Layer the rest of the cheese

Bake uncovered in preheated oven for 20 - 30 minutes, until bubbly.

Serve with Crispy Celery Sticks
