

Perspective - 224 verses contain the word "Truth" in Scripture

1. (Genesis 24:27) And he said, Blessed be the LORD God of my master Abraham, who hath not left destitute my master of his mercy and his **truth**: I being in the way, the LORD led me to the house of my master's brethren.
2. (Genesis 32:10) I am not worthy of the least of all the mercies, and of all the **truth**, which thou hast shewed unto thy servant; for with my staff I passed over this Jordan; and now I am become two bands.
3. (Genesis 42:16) Send one of you, and let him fetch your brother, and ye shall be kept in prison, that your words may be proved, whether there be any **truth** in you: or else by the life of Pharaoh surely ye are spies.
4. (Exodus 18:21) Moreover thou shalt provide out of all the people able men, such as fear God, men of **truth**, hating covetousness; and place such over them, to be rulers of thousands, and rulers of hundreds, rulers of fifties, and rulers of tens:
5. (Exodus 34:6) And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and **truth**,
6. (Deuteronomy 13:14) Then shalt thou enquire, and make search, and ask diligently; and, behold, if it be **truth**, and the thing certain, that such abomination is wrought among you;
7. (Deuteronomy 32:4) He is the Rock, his work is perfect: for all his ways are judgment: a God of **truth** and without iniquity, just and right is he.
8. (Joshua 24:14) Now therefore fear the LORD, and serve him in sincerity and in **truth**: and put away the gods which your fathers served on the other side of the flood, and in Egypt; and serve ye the LORD.
9. (Judges 9:15) And the bramble said unto the trees, If in **truth** ye anoint me king over you, then come and put your trust in my shadow: and if not, let fire come out of the bramble, and devour the cedars of Lebanon.
10. (1 Samuel 12:24) Only fear the LORD, and serve him in **truth** with all your heart: for consider how great things he hath done for you.
11. (1 Samuel 21:5) And David answered the priest, and said unto him, Of a **truth** women have been kept from us about these three days, since I came out, and the vessels of the young men are holy, and the bread is in a manner common, yea, though it were sanctified this day in the vessel.
12. (2 Samuel 2:6) And now the LORD shew kindness and **truth** unto you: and I also will requite you this kindness, because ye have done this thing.
13. (2 Samuel 15:20) Whereas thou camest but yesterday, should I this day make thee go up and down with us? seeing I go whither I may, return thou, and take back thy brethren: mercy and **truth** be with thee.
14. (1 Kings 2:4) That the LORD may continue his word which he spake concerning me, saying, If thy children take heed to their way, to walk before me in **truth** with all their heart and with all their soul, there shall not fail thee (said he) a man on the throne of Israel.
15. (1 Kings 3:6) And Solomon said, Thou hast shewed unto thy servant David my father great mercy, according as he walked before thee in **truth**, and in righteousness, and in uprightness of heart with thee; and thou hast kept for him this great kindness, that thou hast given him a son to sit on his throne, as it is this day.
16. (1 Kings 17:24) And the woman said to Elijah, Now by this I know that thou art a man of God, and that the word of the LORD in thy mouth is **truth**.
17. (2 Kings 19:17) Of a **truth**, LORD, the kings of Assyria have destroyed the nations and their lands,
18. (2 Kings 20:3) I beseech thee, O LORD, remember now how I have walked before thee in **truth** and with a perfect heart, and have done that which is good in thy sight. And Hezekiah wept sore.

19. (2 Kings 20:19) Then said Hezekiah unto Isaiah, Good is the word of the LORD which thou hast spoken. And he said, Is it not good, if peace and **truth** be in my days?
20. (2 Chronicles 18:15) And the king said to him, How many times shall I adjure thee that thou say nothing but the **truth** to me in the name of the LORD?
21. (2 Chronicles 31:20) And thus did Hezekiah throughout all Judah, and wrought that which was good and right and **truth** before the LORD his God.
22. (Esther 9:30) And he sent the letters unto all the Jews, to the hundred twenty and seven provinces of the kingdom of Ahasuerus, with words of peace and **truth**,
23. (Job 9:2) I know it is so of a **truth**: but how should man be just with God?
24. (Psalms 15:2) He that walketh uprightly, and worketh righteousness, and speaketh the **truth** in his heart.
25. (Psalms 25:5) Lead me in thy **truth**, and teach me: for thou art the God of my salvation; on thee do I wait all the day.
26. (Psalms 25:10) All the paths of the LORD are mercy and **truth** unto such as keep his covenant and his testimonies.
27. (Psalms 26:3) For thy lovingkindness is before mine eyes: and I have walked in thy **truth**.
28. (Psalms 30:9) What profit is there in my blood, when I go down to the pit? Shall the dust praise thee? shall it declare thy **truth**?
29. (Psalms 31:5) Into thine hand I commit my spirit: thou hast redeemed me, O LORD God of **truth**.
30. (Psalms 33:4) For the word of the LORD is right; and all his works are done in **truth**.
31. (Psalms 40:10) I have not hid thy righteousness within my heart; I have declared thy faithfulness and thy salvation: I have not concealed thy lovingkindness and thy **truth** from the great congregation.
32. (Psalms 40:11) Withhold not thou thy tender mercies from me, O LORD: let thy lovingkindness and thy **truth** continually preserve me.
33. (Psalms 43:3) O send out thy light and thy **truth**: let them lead me; let them bring me unto thy holy hill, and to thy tabernacles.
34. (Psalms 45:4) And in thy majesty ride prosperously because of **truth** and meekness and righteousness; and thy right hand shall teach thee terrible things.
35. (Psalms 51:6) Behold, thou desirest **truth** in the inward parts: and in the hidden part thou shalt make me to know wisdom.
36. (Psalms 54:5) He shall reward evil unto mine enemies: cut them off in thy **truth**.
37. (Psalms 57:3) He shall send from heaven, and save me from the reproach of him that would swallow me up. Selah. God shall send forth his mercy and his **truth**.
38. (Psalms 57:10) For thy mercy is great unto the heavens, and thy **truth** unto the clouds.
39. (Psalms 60:4) Thou hast given a banner to them that fear thee, that it may be displayed because of the **truth**. Selah.
40. (Psalms 61:7) He shall abide before God for ever: O prepare mercy and **truth**, which may preserve him.
41. (Psalms 69:13) But as for me, my prayer is unto thee, O LORD, in an acceptable time: O God, in the multitude of thy mercy hear me, in the **truth** of thy salvation.

42. (Psalms 71:22) I will also praise thee with the psaltery, even thy **truth**, O my God: unto thee will I sing with the harp, O thou Holy One of Israel.
43. (Psalms 85:10) Mercy and **truth** are met together; righteousness and peace have kissed each other.
44. (Psalms 85:11) **Truth** shall spring out of the earth; and righteousness shall look down from heaven.
45. (Psalms 86:11) Teach me thy way, O LORD; I will walk in thy **truth**: unite my heart to fear thy name.
46. (Psalms 86:15) But thou, O Lord, art a God full of compassion, and gracious, longsuffering, and plenteous in mercy and **truth**.
47. (Psalms 89:14) Justice and judgment are the habitation of thy throne: mercy and **truth** shall go before thy face.
48. (Psalms 89:49) Lord, where are thy former lovingkindnesses, which thou swarest unto David in thy **truth**?
49. (Psalms 91:4) He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his **truth** shall be thy shield and buckler.
50. (Psalms 96:13) Before the LORD: for he cometh, for he cometh to judge the earth: he shall judge the world with righteousness, and the people with his **truth**.
51. (Psalms 98:3) He hath remembered his mercy and his **truth** toward the house of Israel: all the ends of the earth have seen the salvation of our God.
52. (Psalms 100:5) For the LORD is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his **truth** endureth to all generations.
53. (Psalms 108:4) For thy mercy is great above the heavens: and thy **truth** reacheth unto the clouds.
54. (Psalms 111:8) They stand fast for ever and ever, and are done in **truth** and uprightness.
55. (Psalms 115:1) Not unto us, O LORD, not unto us, but unto thy name give glory, for thy mercy, and for thy **truth's** sake.
56. (Psalms 117:2) For his merciful kindness is great toward us: and the **truth** of the LORD endureth for ever. Praise ye the LORD.
57. (Psalms 119:30) I have chosen the way of **truth**: thy judgments have I laid before me.
58. (Psalms 119:43) And take not the word of **truth** utterly out of my mouth; for I have hoped in thy judgments.
59. (Psalms 119:142) Thy righteousness is an everlasting righteousness, and thy law is the **truth**.
60. (Psalms 119:151) Thou art near, O LORD; and all thy commandments are **truth**.
61. (Psalms 132:11) The LORD hath sworn in **truth** unto David; he will not turn from it; Of the fruit of thy body will I set upon thy throne.
62. (Psalms 138:2) I will worship toward thy holy temple, and praise thy name for thy lovingkindness and for thy **truth**: for thou hast magnified thy word above all thy name.
63. (Psalms 145:18) The LORD is nigh unto all them that call upon him, to all that call upon him in **truth**.
64. (Psalms 146:6) Which made heaven, and earth, the sea, and all that therein is: which keepeth **truth** for ever:
65. (Proverbs 3:3) Let not mercy and **truth** forsake thee: bind them about thy neck; write them upon the table of thine heart:
66. (Proverbs 8:7) For my mouth shall speak **truth**; and wickedness is an abomination to my lips.
67. (Proverbs 12:17) He that speaketh **truth** sheweth forth righteousness: but a false witness deceit.

68. (Proverbs 12:19) The lip of **truth** shall be established for ever: but a lying tongue is but for a moment.
69. (Proverbs 14:22) Do they not err that devise evil? but mercy and **truth** shall be to them that devise good.
70. (Proverbs 16:6) By mercy and **truth** iniquity is purged: and by the fear of the LORD men depart from evil.
71. (Proverbs 20:28) Mercy and **truth** preserve the king: and his throne is upholden by mercy.
72. (Proverbs 22:21) That I might make thee know the certainty of the words of **truth**; that thou mightest answer the words of **truth** to them that send unto thee?
73. (Proverbs 23:23) Buy the **truth**, and sell it not; also wisdom, and instruction, and understanding.
74. (Ecclesiastes 12:10) The preacher sought to find out acceptable words: and that which was written was upright, even words of **truth**.
75. (Isaiah 5:9) In mine ears said the LORD of hosts, Of a **truth** many houses shall be desolate, even great and fair, without inhabitant.
76. (Isaiah 10:20) And it shall come to pass in that day, that the remnant of Israel, and such as are escaped of the house of Jacob, shall no more again stay upon him that smote them; but shall stay upon the LORD, the Holy One of Israel, in **truth**.
77. (Isaiah 16:5) And in mercy shall the throne be established: and he shall sit upon it in **truth** in the tabernacle of David, judging, and seeking judgment, and hasting righteousness.
78. (Isaiah 25:1) O LORD, thou art my God; I will exalt thee, I will praise thy name; for thou hast done wonderful things; thy counsels of old are faithfulness and **truth**.
79. (Isaiah 26:2) Open ye the gates, that the righteous nation which keepeth the **truth** may enter in.
80. (Isaiah 37:18) Of a **truth**, LORD, the kings of Assyria have laid waste all the nations, and their countries,
81. (Isaiah 38:3) And said, Remember now, O LORD, I beseech thee, how I have walked before thee in **truth** and with a perfect heart, and have done that which is good in thy sight. And Hezekiah wept sore.
82. (Isaiah 38:18) For the grave cannot praise thee, death can not celebrate thee: they that go down into the pit cannot hope for thy **truth**.
83. (Isaiah 38:19) The living, the living, he shall praise thee, as I do this day: the father to the children shall make known thy **truth**.
84. (Isaiah 39:8) Then said Hezekiah to Isaiah, Good is the word of the LORD which thou hast spoken. He said moreover, For there shall be peace and **truth** in my days.
85. (Isaiah 42:3) A bruised reed shall he not break, and the smoking flax shall he not quench: he shall bring forth judgment unto **truth**.
86. (Isaiah 43:9) Let all the nations be gathered together, and let the people be assembled: who among them can declare this, and shew us former things? let them bring forth their witnesses, that they may be justified: or let them hear, and say, It is **truth**.
87. (Isaiah 48:1) Hear ye this, O house of Jacob, which are called by the name of Israel, and are come forth out of the waters of Judah, which swear by the name of the LORD, and make mention of the God of Israel, but not in **truth**, nor in righteousness.
88. (Isaiah 59:4) None calleth for justice, nor any pleadeth for **truth**: they trust in vanity, and speak lies; they conceive mischief, and bring forth iniquity.
89. (Isaiah 59:14) And judgment is turned away backward, and justice standeth afar off: for **truth** is fallen in the street, and equity cannot enter.

90. (Isaiah 59:15) Yea, **truth** faileth; and he that departeth from evil maketh himself a prey: and the LORD saw it, and it displeased him that there was no judgment.
91. (Isaiah 61:8) For I the LORD love judgment, I hate robbery for burnt offering; and I will direct their work in **truth**, and I will make an everlasting covenant with them.
92. (Isaiah 65:16) That he who blesseth himself in the earth shall bless himself in the God of **truth**; and he that sweareth in the earth shall swear by the God of **truth**; because the former troubles are forgotten, and because they are hid from mine eyes.
93. (Jeremiah 4:2) And thou shalt swear, The LORD liveth, in **truth**, in judgment, and in righteousness; and the nations shall bless themselves in him, and in him shall they glory.
94. (Jeremiah 5:1) Run ye to and fro through the streets of Jerusalem, and see now, and know, and seek in the broad places thereof, if ye can find a man, if there be any that executeth judgment, that seeketh the **truth**; and I will pardon it.
95. (Jeremiah 5:3) O LORD, are not thine eyes upon the **truth**? thou hast stricken them, but they have not grieved; thou hast consumed them, but they have refused to receive correction: they have made their faces harder than a rock; they have refused to return.
96. (Jeremiah 7:28) But thou shalt say unto them, This is a nation that obeyeth not the voice of the LORD their God, nor receiveth correction: **truth** is perished, and is cut off from their mouth.
97. (Jeremiah 9:3) And they bend their tongues like their bow for lies: but they are not valiant for the **truth** upon the earth; for they proceed from evil to evil, and they know not me, saith the LORD.
98. (Jeremiah 9:5) And they will deceive every one his neighbour, and will not speak the **truth**: they have taught their tongue to speak lies, and weary themselves to commit iniquity.
99. (Jeremiah 26:15) But know ye for certain, that if ye put me to death, ye shall surely bring innocent blood upon yourselves, and upon this city, and upon the inhabitants thereof: for of a **truth** the LORD hath sent me unto you to speak all these words in your ears.
100. (Jeremiah 33:6) Behold, I will bring it health and cure, and I will cure them, and will reveal unto them the abundance of peace and **truth**.
101. (Daniel 2:47) The king answered unto Daniel, and said, Of a **truth** it is, that your God is a God of gods, and a Lord of kings, and a revealer of secrets, seeing thou couldest reveal this secret.
102. (Daniel 4:37) Now I Nebuchadnezzar praise and extol and honour the King of heaven, all whose works are **truth**, and his ways judgment: and those that walk in pride he is able to abase.
103. (Daniel 7:16) I came near unto one of them that stood by, and asked him the **truth** of all this. So he told me, and made me know the interpretation of the things.
104. (Daniel 7:19) Then I would know the **truth** of the fourth beast, which was diverse from all the others, exceeding dreadful, whose teeth were of iron, and his nails of brass; which devoured, brake in pieces, and stamped the residue with his feet;
105. (Daniel 8:12) And an host was given him against the daily sacrifice by reason of transgression, and it cast down the **truth** to the ground; and it practised, and prospered.
106. (Daniel 9:13) As it is written in the law of Moses, all this evil is come upon us: yet made we not our prayer before the LORD our God, that we might turn from our iniquities, and understand thy **truth**.
107. (Daniel 10:21) But I will shew thee that which is noted in the scripture of **truth**: and there is none that holdeth with me in these things, but Michael your prince.

108. (Daniel 11:2) And now will I shew thee the **truth**. Behold, there shall stand up yet three kings in Persia; and the fourth shall be far richer than they all: and by his strength through his riches he shall stir up all against the realm of Grecia.
109. (Hosea 4:1) Hear the word of the LORD, ye children of Israel: for the LORD hath a controversy with the inhabitants of the land, because there is no **truth**, nor mercy, nor knowledge of God in the land.
110. (Micah 7:20) Thou wilt perform the **truth** to Jacob, and the mercy to Abraham, which thou hast sworn unto our fathers from the days of old.
111. (Zechariah 8:3) Thus saith the LORD; I am returned unto Zion, and will dwell in the midst of Jerusalem: and Jerusalem shall be called a city of **truth**; and the mountain of the LORD of hosts the holy mountain.
112. (Zechariah 8:8) And I will bring them, and they shall dwell in the midst of Jerusalem: and they shall be my people, and I will be their God, in **truth** and in righteousness.
113. (Zechariah 8:16) These are the things that ye shall do; Speak ye every man the **truth** to his neighbour; execute the judgment of **truth** and peace in your gates:
114. (Zechariah 8:19) Thus saith the LORD of hosts; The fast of the fourth month, and the fast of the fifth, and the fast of the seventh, and the fast of the tenth, shall be to the house of Judah joy and gladness, and cheerful feasts; therefore love the **truth** and peace.
115. (Malachi 2:6) The law of **truth** was in his mouth, and iniquity was not found in his lips: he walked with me in peace and equity, and did turn many away from iniquity.
116. (Matthew 14:33) Then they that were in the ship came and worshipped him, saying, Of a **truth** thou art the Son of God.
117. (Matthew 15:27) And she said, **Truth**, Lord: yet the dogs eat of the crumbs which fall from their masters' table.
118. (Matthew 22:16) And they sent out unto him their disciples with the Herodians, saying, Master, we know that thou art **true**, and teachest the way of God in **truth**, neither carest thou for any man: for thou regardest not the person of men.
119. (Mark 5:33) But the woman fearing and trembling, knowing what was done in her, came and fell down before him, and told him all the **truth**.
120. (Mark 12:14) And when they were come, they say unto him, Master, we know that thou art **true**, and carest for no man: for thou regardest not the person of men, but teachest the way of God in **truth**: Is it lawful to give tribute to Caesar, or not?
121. (Mark 12:32) And the scribe said unto him, Well, Master, thou hast said the **truth**: for there is one God; and there is none other but he:
122. (Luke 4:25) But I tell you of a **truth**, many widows were in Israel in the days of Elias, when the heaven was shut up three years and six months, when great famine was throughout all the land;
123. (Luke 9:27) But I tell you of a **truth**, there be some standing here, which shall not taste of death, till they see the kingdom of God.
124. (Luke 12:44) Of a **truth** I say unto you, that he will make him ruler over all that he hath.
125. (Luke 21:3) And he said, Of a **truth** I say unto you, that this poor widow hath cast in more than they all:
126. (Luke 22:59) And about the space of one hour after another confidently affirmed, saying, Of a **truth** this fellow also was with him: for he is a Galilaean.
127. (John 1:14) And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and **truth**.

128. (John 1:17) For the law was given by Moses, but grace and **truth** came by Jesus Christ.
129. (John 3:21) But he that doeth **truth** cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God.
130. (John 4:23) But the hour cometh, and now is, when the **true** worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in **truth**: for the Father seeketh such to worship him.
131. (John 4:24) God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in **truth**.
132. (John 5:33) Ye sent unto John, and he bare witness unto the **truth**.
133. (John 6:14) Then those men, when they had seen the miracle that Jesus did, said, This is of a **truth** that prophet that should come into the world.
134. (John 7:40) Many of the people therefore, when they heard this saying, said, Of a **truth** this is the Prophet.
135. (John 8:32) And ye shall know the **truth**, and the **truth** shall make you free.
136. (John 8:40) But now ye seek to kill me, a man that hath told you the **truth**, which I have heard of God: this did not Abraham.
137. (John 8:44) Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the **truth**, because there is no **truth** in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.
138. (John 8:45) And because I tell you the **truth**, ye believe me not.
139. (John 8:46) Which of you convinceth me of sin? And if I say the **truth**, why do ye not believe me?
140. (John 14:6) Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the **truth**, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.
141. (John 14:17) Even the Spirit of **truth**; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.
142. (John 15:26) But when the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of **truth**, which proceedeth from the Father, he shall testify of me:
143. (John 16:7) Nevertheless I tell you the **truth**; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you.
144. (John 16:13) Howbeit when he, the Spirit of **truth**, is come, he will guide you into all **truth**: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.
145. (John 17:17) Sanctify them through thy **truth**: thy word is **truth**.
146. (John 17:19) And for their sakes I sanctify myself, that they also might be sanctified through the **truth**.
147. (John 18:37) Pilate therefore said unto him, Art thou a king then? Jesus answered, Thou sayest that I am a king. To this end was I born, and for this cause came I into the world, that I should bear witness unto the **truth**. Every one that is of the **truth** heareth my voice.
148. (John 18:38) Pilate saith unto him, What is **truth**? And when he had said this, he went out again unto the Jews, and saith unto them, I find in him no fault at all.
149. (Acts 4:27) For of a **truth** against thy holy child Jesus, whom thou hast anointed, both Herod, and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles, and the people of Israel, were gathered together,
150. (Acts 10:34) Then Peter opened his mouth, and said, Of a **truth** I perceive that God is no respecter of persons:

151. (Acts 26:25) But he said, I am not mad, most noble Festus; but speak forth the words of **truth** and soberness.
152. (Romans 1:18) For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the **truth** in unrighteousness;
153. (Romans 1:25) Who changed the **truth** of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed for ever. Amen.
154. (Romans 2:2) But we are sure that the judgment of God is according to **truth** against them which commit such things.
155. (Romans 2:8) But unto them that are contentious, and do not obey the **truth**, but obey unrighteousness, indignation and wrath,
156. (Romans 2:20) An instructor of the foolish, a teacher of babes, which hast the form of knowledge and of the **truth** in the law.
157. (Romans 3:7) For if the **truth** of God hath more abounded through my lie unto his glory; why yet am I also judged as a sinner?
158. (Romans 9:1) I say the **truth** in Christ, I lie not, my conscience also bearing me witness in the Holy Ghost,
159. (Romans 15:8) Now I say that Jesus Christ was a minister of the circumcision for the **truth** of God, to confirm the promises made unto the fathers:
160. (1 Corinthians 5:8) Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and **truth**.
161. (1 Corinthians 13:6) Rejoiceth not in iniquity, but rejoiceth in the **truth**;
162. (1 Corinthians 14:25) And thus are the secrets of his heart made manifest; and so falling down on his face he will worship God, and report that God is in you of a **truth**.
163. (2 Corinthians 4:2) But have renounced the hidden things of dishonesty, not walking in craftiness, nor handling the word of God deceitfully; but by manifestation of the **truth** commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God.
164. (2 Corinthians 6:7) By the word of **truth**, by the power of God, by the armour of righteousness on the right hand and on the left,
165. (2 Corinthians 7:14) For if I have boasted any thing to him of you, I am not ashamed; but as we spake all things to you in **truth**, even so our boasting, which I made before Titus, is found a **truth**.
166. (2 Corinthians 11:10) As the **truth** of Christ is in me, no man shall stop me of this boasting in the regions of Achaia.
167. (2 Corinthians 12:6) For though I would desire to glory, I shall not be a fool; for I will say the **truth**: but now I forbear, lest any man should think of me above that which he seeth me to be, or that he heareth of me.
168. (2 Corinthians 13:8) For we can do nothing against the **truth**, but for the **truth**.
169. (Galatians 2:5) To whom we gave place by subjection, no, not for an hour; that the **truth** of the gospel might continue with you.
170. (Galatians 2:14) But when I saw that they walked not uprightly according to the **truth** of the gospel, I said unto Peter before them all, If thou, being a Jew, livest after the manner of Gentiles, and not as do the Jews, why compellest thou the Gentiles to live as do the Jews?

171. (Galatians 3:1) O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the **truth**, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you?
172. (Galatians 4:16) Am I therefore become your enemy, because I tell you the **truth**?
173. (Galatians 5:7) Ye did run well; who did hinder you that ye should not obey the **truth**?
174. (Ephesians 1:13) In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of **truth**, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,
175. (Ephesians 4:15) But speaking the **truth** in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ:
176. (Ephesians 4:21) If so be that ye have heard him, and have been taught by him, as the **truth** is in Jesus:
177. (Ephesians 4:25) Wherefore putting away lying, speak every man **truth** with his neighbour: for we are members one of another.
178. (Ephesians 5:9) (For the fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness and righteousness and **truth**;))
179. (Ephesians 6:14) Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with **truth**, and having on the breastplate of righteousness;
180. (Philippians 1:18) What then? notwithstanding, every way, whether in pretence, or in **truth**, Christ is preached; and I therein do rejoice, yea, and will rejoice.
181. (Colossians 1:5) For the hope which is laid up for you in heaven, whereof ye heard before in the word of the **truth** of the gospel;
182. (Colossians 1:6) Which is come unto you, as it is in all the world; and bringeth forth fruit, as it doth also in you, since the day ye heard of it, and knew the grace of God in **truth**:
183. (1 Thessalonians 2:13) For this cause also thank we God without ceasing, because, when ye received the word of God which ye heard of us, ye received it not as the word of men, but as it is in **truth**, the word of God, which effectually worketh also in you that believe.
184. (2 Thessalonians 2:10) And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the **truth**, that they might be saved.
185. (2 Thessalonians 2:12) That they all might be damned who believed not the **truth**, but had pleasure in unrighteousness.
186. (2 Thessalonians 2:13) But we are bound to give thanks alway to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the **truth**:
187. (1 Timothy 2:4) Who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the **truth**.
188. (1 Timothy 2:7) Whereunto I am ordained a preacher, and an apostle, (I speak the **truth** in Christ, and lie not;) a teacher of the Gentiles in faith and verity.
189. (1 Timothy 3:15) But if I tarry long, that thou mayest know how thou oughtest to behave thyself in the house of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and ground of the **truth**.
190. (1 Timothy 4:3) Forbidding to marry, and commanding to abstain from meats, which God hath created to be received with thanksgiving of them which believe and know the **truth**.
191. (1 Timothy 6:5) Perverse disputings of men of corrupt minds, and destitute of the **truth**, supposing that gain is godliness: from such withdraw thyself.
192. (2 Timothy 2:15) Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of **truth**.

193. (2 Timothy 2:18) Who concerning the **truth** have erred, saying that the resurrection is past already; and overthrow the faith of some.
194. (2 Timothy 2:25) In meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the **truth**;
195. (2 Timothy 3:7) Ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of the **truth**.
196. (2 Timothy 3:8) Now as Jannes and Jambres withstood Moses, so do these also resist the **truth**: men of corrupt minds, reprobate concerning the faith.
197. (2 Timothy 4:4) And they shall turn away their ears from the **truth**, and shall be turned unto fables.
198. (Titus 1:1) Paul, a servant of God, and an apostle of Jesus Christ, according to the faith of God's elect, and the acknowledging of the **truth** which is after godliness;
199. (Titus 1:14) Not giving heed to Jewish fables, and commandments of men, that turn from the **truth**.
200. (Hebrews 10:26) For if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of the **truth**, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins,
201. (James 1:18) Of his own will begat he us with the word of **truth**, that we should be a kind of firstfruits of his creatures.
202. (James 3:14) But if ye have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the **truth**.
203. (James 5:19) Brethren, if any of you do err from the **truth**, and one convert him;
204. (1 Peter 1:22) Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the **truth** through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently:
205. (2 Peter 1:12) Wherefore I will not be negligent to put you always in remembrance of these things, though ye know them, and be established in the present **truth**.
206. (2 Peter 2:2) And many shall follow their pernicious ways; by reason of whom the way of **truth** shall be evil spoken of.
207. (1 John 1:6) If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the **truth**:
208. (1 John 1:8) If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the **truth** is not in us.
209. (1 John 2:4) He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the **truth** is not in him.
210. (1 John 2:21) I have not written unto you because ye know not the **truth**, but because ye know it, and that no lie is of the **truth**.
211. (1 John 2:27) But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is **truth**, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him.
212. (1 John 3:18) My little children, let us not love in word, neither in tongue; but in deed and in **truth**.
213. (1 John 3:19) And hereby we know that we are of the **truth**, and shall assure our hearts before him.
214. (1 John 4:6) We are of God: he that knoweth God heareth us; he that is not of God heareth not us. Hereby know we the spirit of **truth**, and the spirit of error.

215. (1 John 5:6) This is he that came by water and blood, even Jesus Christ; not by water only, but by water and blood. And it is the Spirit that beareth witness, because the Spirit is **truth**.
216. (2 John 1:1) The elder unto the elect lady and her children, whom I love in the **truth**; and not I only, but also all they that have known the **truth**;
217. (2 John 1:2) For the **truth's** sake, which dwelleth in us, and shall be with us for ever.
218. (2 John 1:3) Grace be with you, mercy, and peace, from God the Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of the Father, in **truth** and love.
219. (2 John 1:4) I rejoiced greatly that I found of thy children walking in **truth**, as we have received a commandment from the Father.
220. (3 John 1:1) The elder unto the wellbeloved Gaius, whom I love in the **truth**.
221. (3 John 1:3) For I rejoiced greatly, when the brethren came and testified of the **truth** that is in thee, even as thou walkest in the **truth**.
222. (3 John 1:4) I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in **truth**.
223. (3 John 1:8) We therefore ought to receive such, that we might be fellowhelpers to the **truth**.
224. (3 John 1:12) Demetrius hath good report of all men, and of the **truth** itself: yea, and we also bear record; and ye know that our record is **true**.
