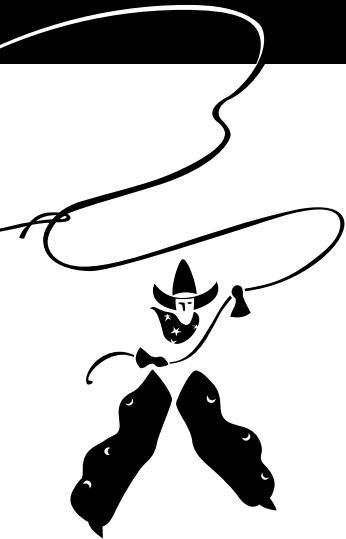


The West – Old, New, Wild, True

CALL FOR ENTRIES

Deadline for entries: June 30, 2009

Exhibit dates: September 4 – 7, 2009

Exhibit location: Chautauqua Community House, Boulder CO

This year marks the 150th anniversary of the City of Boulder. To celebrate, the Colorado Chautauqua Association has invited Boulder Art Association (BAA) back for their second annual juried art exhibition at the historic Chautauqua Community House.

This prospectus carefully outlines the process and guidelines to submit your artwork for consideration by the Juror. **PLEASE READ THE ENTIRE PROSPECTUS CAREFULLY BEFORE CONTACTING BOULDER ART ASSOCIATION WITH QUESTIONS.** Incomplete submissions and submissions that do not follow the guidelines will not be accepted.

JUROR

Mary Williams has been involved in the fine art business since moving to Colorado in 1981. She spent the first part of her career managing 2 art galleries, and in 1996 she was fortunate enough to open her own. The gallery is located at 2116 Pearl Street in Boulder. They specialize in antique prints and maps that focus on the American West and original artworks by established Rocky Mountain artists. The gallery is also known for its superior custom framing and has been a thriving local business for fourteen years.

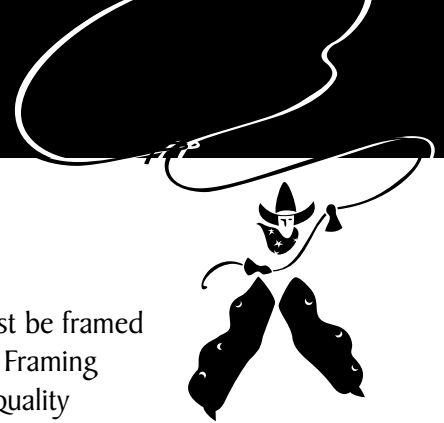
JUDGING

Artwork for the exhibition will be chosen from images submitted (i.e.: the artwork submitted must be available for exhibition). **ONLY CD's MAY BE SUBMITTED.** Submissions via email will not be accepted. If selected for exhibition, the artist must hand-deliver the exact artwork chosen by the Juror. Notification by mail for accepted entries will be mailed on (or near) August 10, 2009. CD's will **NOT** be returned.

AWARDS

BAA is giving away \$2000 in cash awards including a People's Choice Award to be given away at the end of the exhibit.

ELIGIBILITY

- ★ Work must relate to the show's theme
- ★ Open to all artists in the Rocky Mountain region. Art work requiring shipping is not eligible
- ★ Artists in all media are encouraged to apply
- ★ Installations and giclées will not be accepted
- ★ Digital submissions on a CD only
- ★ Work must have been completed in the last two years
- ★ All artwork must be original in concept and execution
- ★ BAA Membership is optional. Space is provided on the entry form to join BAA and enjoy discounted entry fees, a monthly newsletter and member meeting, exhibit opportunities, and other benefits. For more information visit www.boulderartassociation.org.

ENTRIES

- ★ Each artist is encouraged to submit one to three works
- ★ A \$25 for BAA members, or \$35 for non-members, non-refundable Entry Fee must accompany your submission
- ★ Submissions on CD only, following the "Digital Submission" guidelines outlined in this prospectus

DIGITAL SUBMISSIONS

- ★ One to three images may be entered. Digital files should be submitted on a CD enclosed with your entry form
- ★ CDs will not be returned
- ★ Images must be jpeg format, 1200 pixels in the longest dimension, 300 dpi, and no larger than 1.5Mb in total file size
- ★ Please crop images to exclude framing and matting.
- ★ Name your file: the first four (4) letters of your last name; a hyphen; the first four letters of your first name; a hyphen, entry #; and your painting title (i.e., thom-mali-1NotSoSecret.jpg)
- ★ Write your name, phone, e-mail address, and image title(s) on the CD

DELIVERY AND RETURN OF ARTWORK

- ★ All work must be hand-delivered to the Chautauqua Community House on September 3 between 12:00 PM and 4:00 PM. We cannot accept shipped art. Substitutions for accepted work that has been sold prior to the show will NOT be allowed.
- ★ Unsold work must be picked up on September 7 between 4:00 PM and 6:00 PM

PRESENTATION

- ★ All 2-D entries must be framed and ready to hang. Framing must meet gallery quality standards. Frames must be suitable to the work and the Exhibit, must be undamaged and reinforced with hardware and wire in place.
- ★ No saw-tooth hangers
- ★ Not to exceed 48" in any direction (including frame size)
- ★ Sculptures must have their own display base

SALES OF ARTWORK

All works must be offered for sale. BAA will retain 30% commission on all sold works. Prices cannot be changed after entry submission. We request that sold artwork remains on display until the end of the show at 4:00 PM, September 7th.

LIABILITY

BAA agrees to handle all work with extreme care, but will not be liable for theft or damage during the exhibit. If you wish to insure your work, you must make your own arrangements.

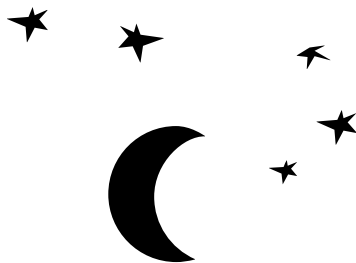
