Red Rose Farm Teatowel

Red Rose Farm Teatowel

Yardage Requirements (all fabrics are from the Red Rose Farm collection by Elizabeth Scott for P&B Textiles):

Rose image (ROFA557E)

2" x width of fabric strip for band (ROFA562P)

6" x width of fabric strip for ruffle (ROFA561B)

Cotton teatowel

8" x 8" square of lightweight fusible web

Instructions:

1. Cut the piece of fusible web slightly larger than the rose motif. Fuse to the wrong side of the rose motif and cut out leaving about 1/8" margin around the motif.
2. Fuse to the front of the towel. Machine blanket stitch around the motif using matching thread.
3. Turn in and press short ends of ruffle 1/4". Fold ruffle in half wrong sides together and press. Gather using a ruffler foot or by stitching 2 rows of basting stitches close to raw edge.
4. Position ruffle on front of teatowel 1 1/2" from one hemmed edge. Machine baste in place.
5. Fold both ends of the trim strip 1/2" to the wrong side and press. Turn under one short end and press. Position strip on top of the ruffle, making sure to cover the ruffle stitching. Turn under remaining short end. Topstitch in place close to all edges.
