

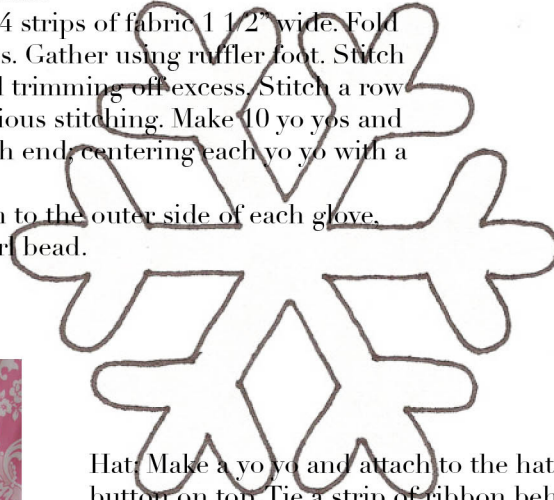
# Sweet Simple Scarf Sets

Here's what you'll need:  
 Hat, scarf and glove set (ours were from Target)  
 Fabric scraps, buttons, trims  
 Clover YoYo Maker (30mm size)

**Hat:** Position a crocheted flower onto the hat and stitch in place adding pearl beads to flower center.

**Scarf:** Use pinking blade to cut 4 strips of fabric 1 1/2" wide. Fold each in half widthwise and press. Gather using ruffler foot. Stitch in place folding under ends and trimming off excess. Stitch a row of baby rick rack on top of previous stitching. Make 10 yo yos and stitch 5 along the bottom of each end, centering each yo yo with a pearl bead.

**Gloves:** Make 6 yo yos and stitch to the outer side of each glove, centering each yo yo with a pearl bead.

**Hat:** Make a yo yo and attach to the hat centering a sparkly button on top. Tie a strip of ribbon behind the yo yo.

**Scarf:** Use spray adhesive to attach a fabric square to the front of the scarf and machine blanket stitch around edges. Using a pinking blade cut a 1 1/2" strip of fabric, fold in half widthwise and gather into a circle. Cut off excess fabric. Cut a 1" circle of felt and stitch or glue the gathered circle onto the felt. Cut out a contrasting circle of fabric and pink the edges. Place on top of the gathered circle. Stitch a sparkly button on top, stitching thru all layers. Add a pin back to the felt and pin to the front of the scarf.

**Gloves:** Make 6 yo yos and stitch to the outer side of each glove, centering each yo yo with a sparkly button.

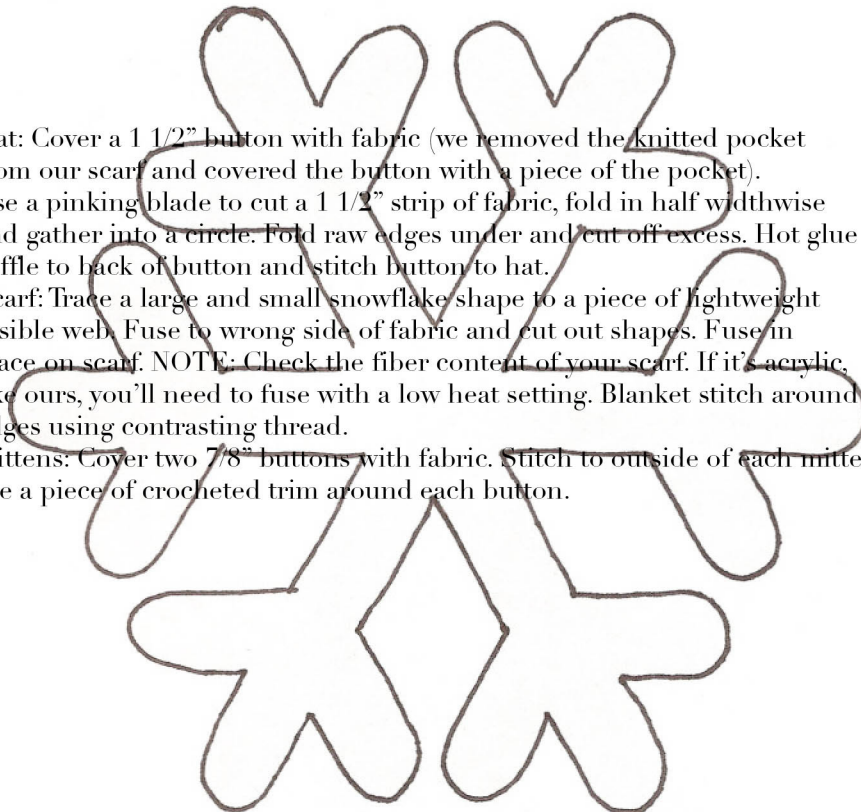
## Pink Set



**Hat:** Cover a 1 1/2" button with fabric (we removed the knitted pocket from our scarf and covered the button with a piece of the pocket). Use a pinking blade to cut a 1 1/2" strip of fabric, fold in half widthwise and gather into a circle. Fold raw edges under and cut off excess. Hot glue ruffle to back of button and stitch button to hat.

**Scarf:** Trace a large and small snowflake shape to a piece of lightweight fusible web. Fuse to wrong side of fabric and cut out shapes. Fuse in place on scarf. NOTE: Check the fiber content of your scarf. If it's acrylic, like ours, you'll need to fuse with a low heat setting. Blanket stitch around edges using contrasting thread.

**Mittens:** Cover two 7/8" buttons with fabric. Stitch to outside of each mitten. Tie a piece of crocheted trim around each button.
