Father Phillip Cascia

Father Philip Cascia, former administrator of O.L.M. in Plainville. past away January 16 at the young age of 55. Father Cascia founded St. Vincent de Paul Society in Waterbury in 1978. They operate a soup kitchen, thrift store and the largest homeless shelter in Connecticut. In 1985 Father Cascia a chaplain at Sacred Heart High school in Waterbury, while their he coached wrestling and arranged to take wrestlers to the Soviet Union and Vietnam. As a result of the trip President Reagan commissioned Farther Cascia to establish a program to develop cultural exchanges between sports teams in the United States and countries around the world. The resulting program is Intersport USA. Through his sports exchange program, the globe trotting Father Cascia had met with leaders of China, Libya, Cuba, Iran, North Korea and Russia.

He witnessed unprecedented meetings in Rome in 1989 between Pope John Paul II and Soviet Pesident Mikhail s. Gobachev. On Feb 1, 2999, the United States Congress nominated Father Casica for the Nobel Peace Prize for his work with Intersport USA.

At his memorial mass some of the speakers spoke about his character and how he could make friends with everyone he met. How he walked around the White house politicking for his cause with no problems. He traveled to war countries with no problems. We have truly lost a good person that moved people in the right direction. He will truly be missed.
