An exciting collection of programs for older Scouts and Venturers can feature events such as: Rock Climbing, Caving, Horseback Riding, Black Powder Rifle Shooting, Mt. Biking, Kayaking, Canoeing, and more. The following guidelines and policies help to ensure a quality high adventure program for your crew.

Age: All youth attending during 2000 must be 13 years of age by first day of your camp.

Physicals: A BSA "PERSONAL HEALTH RECORD FORM – CLASS 3" (FORM #34412) is required by all participants. All Class 3 activities (High Adventure) require a health examination within the past 12 months by a physician.

Crew Size: 8 to 12 crew members including adult leaders.

Unit Reservation Deposits: a \$100.00 non-refundable, unit deposit is required.

Space Available: All space available will go to First come first served with full fees paid.
Dates of full payment will determine admittance for space available.

Fee Payments: Fee Discounts are available for early FULL FEE PAYMENT in the Marriott Scout Service Center. All full fees are due, at the latest, four weeks prior to your camp arrival date. (check for discounts available).

Bus Service: Bus Service is available to Goshen. Transportation from the Virginia/Washington, DC area to Goshen and back is available for a fee. Projected fee for round trip **or** one way bus transportation is \$22.00 and is subject to change depending on the Bus Company contract.

Arrival Time: We request that units check into Lenhok'sin between 2:00 PM and 3:00 PM on the arrival date. (no sooner, no later).

Fees: Youth and adult fees are found on the back of this sheet. Bus fees are in addition to the camp fee.
