RE: **CAPM RENEWAL NOTICE FOR 2009**

Dear Fellows and Members of the California Academy of Preventive Medicine (CAPM):

**CAPM depends on dues** as its sole source of revenue. How does CAPM use the dues?

- To pay fees and partially offset travel expenses **to represent public health and preventive medicine at the California Medical Association (CMA)**. At the 2009 House of Delegates, Dr. Caroline Peck was our delegate and Dr. Ron Hattis the alternate. We submit our own resolutions for CMA policy and vote on the resolutions of others. CAPM can be very influential at CMA as policies are adopted by organized medicine.
- **To communicate with CAPM members.** Our Web site <http://capm.us> contains job announcements, past issues of our newsletter, and other documents and links of interest.

In addition:

- We are the **California component society of the American College of Preventive Medicine (ACPM)**.
- We provide **leadership on preventive medicine issues and programs**.
- We **convene meetings for members** such as the ones held in person and by conference call in coordination with meetings of the California Conference of Local Health Officers.

**Renewal involves the following steps:**

1. **Please make out a check to CAPM for the appropriate amount.** Dues are \$35 for Fellows and Members, \$15 for retired physicians, \$10 for resident physicians, and \$5 for medical students. (Due to rising costs for postage and for CMA participation, we had to increase dues for Fellows and Members this year.)
2. **Complete the CAPM renewal form** (see next page).
3. **Return your check and form in the enclosed envelope** to our Sacramento address.

I hope you will continue to support CAPM as the voice for preventive medicine in California. If you know of other physicians interested in preventive medicine who are not yet members, please inform us. Also, if you would like to become more active in CAPM (e.g., by running for an office), please indicate this on the renewal form.
