NOTICE OF RACE

INVITATION: The Portland Yacht Club and St. Helens Sailing Club cordially invite all eligible boats to participate in the PYC & SHSC Gold Rush, to be held on the Columbia River.

DESCRIPTION: This race consists of one race on Saturday downriver around a designated mark and back upriver to finish at St. Helens. All boats will finish at St. Helens.

ELIGIBILITY AND INSTRUCTIONS: All skippers must be members in good standing of a PIYA recognized yacht club. All boats must have a current PHRF rating unless sailing one design or level fleet. If a boat is not listed in the current PHRF roster, submit a photocopy of the rating certificate with your entry form. Races shall be governed by the current ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing including the national prescriptions of US Sailing, as modified by the OCSA Sailing Instructions, applicable level or one design rules, and the supplemental instructions of this notice.

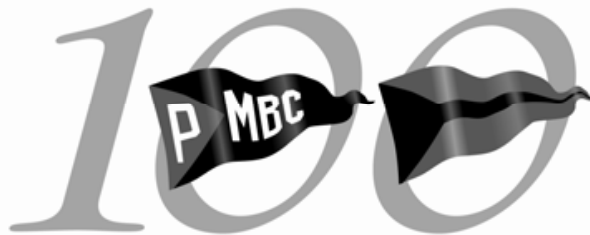
Before 72 hours prior to the first race. Number of fleets and trophies per fleet will be determined by number of boats entered by due date.

SUPPLEMENTAL SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

CLASS DIVISIONS: Will be posted on or distributed by the committee boat

COURSES: All classes will start at the navigational marker #40 and proceed downriver. Classes A, B and J-24 will round the red buoy #60 at the entrance of Martin Slough. All other classes will round the green buoy #75 (approximately 2 miles below Sand Island). After rounding the downriver mark, all classes will proceed up river to finish in front of the public moorage at St. Helens in the vicinity of the court house.

SCORING: All races will be scored in accordance with the OCSA sailing instructions.



TROPHIES: Trophies will be based on the number of boats in each class registered by the registration deadline and will be presented at the Dockside Steak & Pasta, 343 South 1st St., after the race.

PROTESTS: Protesting boats must notify the Race Committee of their intention to protest at the end of the race. Protests must meet the requirements of the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing. The Race Committee will be available at the St. Helens Public Dock to receive any protest within the prescribed time limit.

COMMUNICATIONS: Additional Supplemental Race Instructions may be available from the committee boat.

SOCIAL: There will be a post-race gathering at the Dockside Steak & Pasta, 343 South 1st Street, after the race.
