

# GREAT SOUTHERN KNIFE SHOW

## 2005 SHOW RULES

- 1.) **Table rates** for the Great Southern Knife Show (GSKS) are **\$65.00** per table for the first 5 tables with additional tables (over 5) being **\$50.00** each. **Electrical outlets** are **\$10.00** per plugged in device. For guaranteed table reservations, all payments must be received by GSKS prior to August 6, 2005. **Checks** should be **Payable To: FLINT RIVER KNIFE CLUB, and mailed to David Prowell, 555 Spence Rd., Fairburn, GA 30213.** Payments are considered non-refundable except for special circumstances as determined by Show Management. Table reservations that are canceled revert back to GSKS, and reselling of tables is the sole responsibility of GSKS.
- 2.) Discounts for **Display Tables** will not be considered until 30 days prior to the show date. If you would be interested in purchasing a display table, please **check the box** on the **Knife Exhibitor Registration Form** and you will be contacted by Show Management. No vending will be allowed from any display table purchased at a discounted price.
- 3.) Vendor tables must contain at least 75% knives or knife-related items. Show Management reserves the right to evaluate table displays and if necessary, require vendors to remove items or request that vendors leave the show.
- 4.) **NO GUNS** (either for sale or for personal protection), **ALCOHOL, OR SMOKING** will be allowed inside the Cobb Civic Center. These are **PROHIBITED BY STATE AND LOCAL LAWS** as well as the Show Management.
- 5.) Set up is slated to begin Friday (Oct. 7, 2005) at 2:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. Those wishing to set up on Saturday (Oct. 8, 2005) morning may do so from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. The show will be open to the general public on Saturday at 9:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. and on Sunday (Oct. 9, 2005) at 10:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. Vendors must maintain their table or display until 4:00 p.m. Sunday unless other arrangements have been approved by Show Management at least one week prior to the show. All vendor items must be removed from Cobb Civic Center by 6:00 p.m. on Sunday.
- 6.) Under no circumstances should exhibitors leave valuables unattended during show hours. The Show Management will provide protective services from Cobb County Police during the periods the show is closed to Exhibitors. (Friday 8:00 p.m. until Saturday 7:00 a.m. and Saturday 5:00 p.m. until Sunday 9:00 a.m.). Also, an armed Cobb County police officer will be assisting Show Management during regular show hours.
- 7.) The Show Management reserves the right to refuse rental space to anyone when, in Show Management's opinion, such rental would not be in the best interest of the show, other exhibitors, or customers.
- 8.) The Show Management reserves the right to amend or add to the list of show rules at any time for the good of the show, exhibitors, or customers. Any changes will be posted at the front desk.
