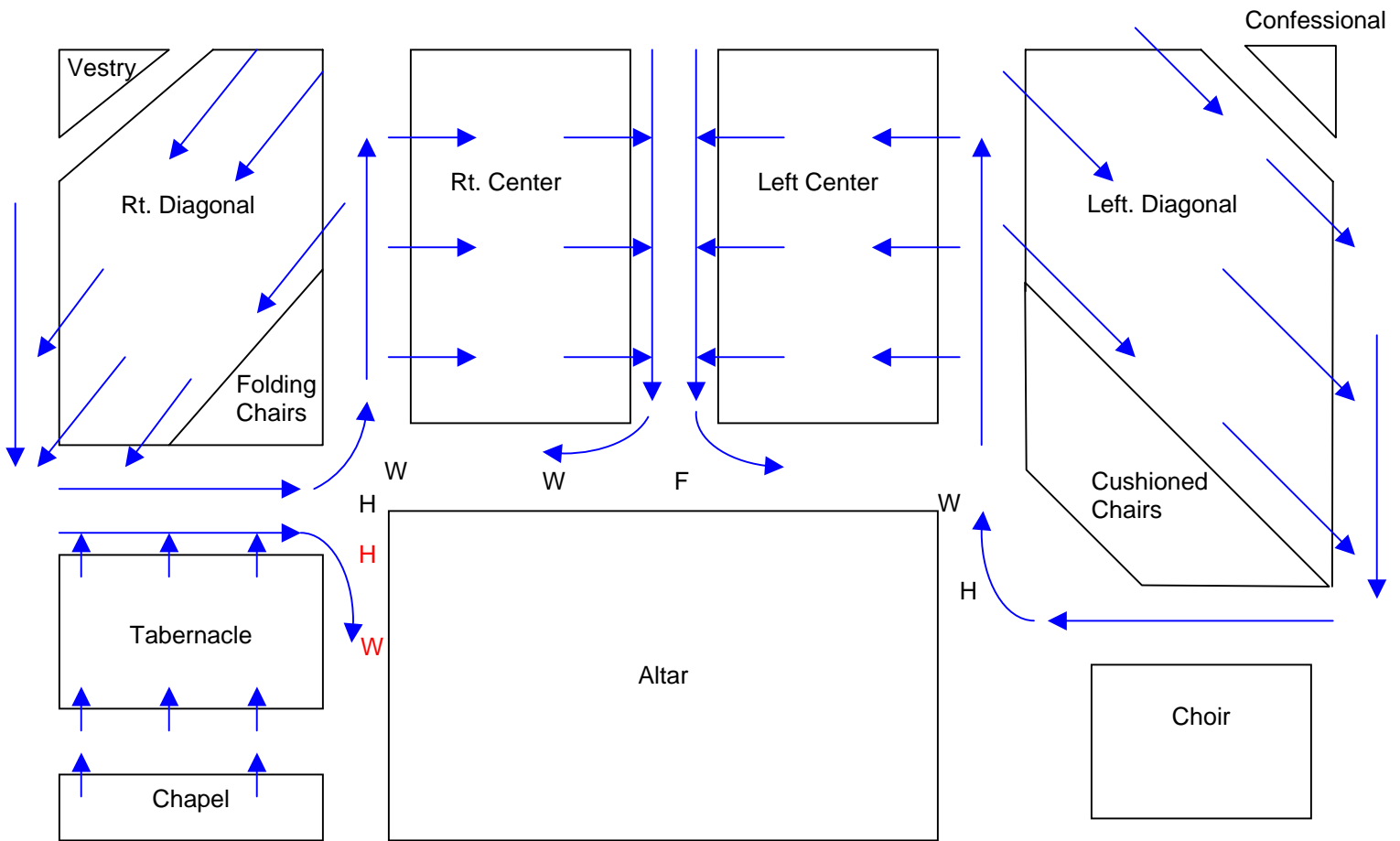


New Communion Station EM Relocation

Problem: When we have 4 full communion stations (Christmas and Easter), the Rt. Diagonal side takes the longest to go to communion. In the past we have used the *Communion Wine Station Rotation* to let the Tabernacle and Chapel go first, then the Right Diagonal side goes next, after the Wine station Rotates. The problem is that Rt. Diagonal side takes the longest, and the last 3 rows always end up going to communion via the center. This is difficult with the additional chairs in the back (reduced aisle space) at these masses

This new Relocation will initially use two sets of EM on the Tabernacle side, one set for the Tabernacle and chapel, and the second for the Diagonal seats. This is how the initial Communion Stations will look like, where:

F = Father Roger, H = Host, W = Wine
 —▶ = Parishioner Communion Flow



After the Tabernacle and Chapel pews have received Communion that Host and Wine EMs will relocate to the Right of Father Roger

And the flow continues
