

Instructions for filling out our application worksheet for NSCAR membership:

Lineage

The lineage section is to be filled out from the applicant down to and including the Revolutionary Ancestor. Each generation must be linked, connecting child to parents as reflected by the references supplied and listed on the application worksheet. Full dates and places for each generation of the lineage should be supplied. Insufficient information about any generation will delay or hinder approval of the application.

- Generation 1. The applicant's full birth date and place of birth must be given. A birth certificate with the names of the child's biological father and mother listed will document the link to the next generation.
- Generation 2 and 3. In these two generations relating to the parents and grandparents of the applicant, all dates (day, month, year) and all places of birth, marriages and death (city and state, or county and state) are required. No exceptions are permitted without satisfactory explanation.
- Generations 4 and 5. Full information about the parents and grandparents of the most remote living ancestor is requested. For example, if the lineage is traced through the applicant's grandmother, who is now living, the application should show full information about the grandmother's parents and grandparents.
- Generations continuing to the Revolutionary Ancestor. Each generation must be completed, connecting child to parents as reflected by the references supplied and listed on the application worksheet.
- Generation of the son or daughter of the Revolutionary Ancestor. This child must be firmly linked by a legal record or original document naming the parent of the child through whom descent is claimed.
- Generation of Revolutionary Ancestor. Dates and places of birth, marriage and death of the ancestor through whose service the application is made, and the place of residence during the Revolutionary period must be given. The name of the wife of Revolutionary Ancestor should also be shown. Should it be impossible to locate complete dates of birth and death of the Revolutionary ancestor, evidence must be submitted to prove the ancestor was living during the Revolution and of suitable age for service. The evidence cannot be the service record itself.

References

References are required to be listed for each generation of the lineage linking each child to parents using primary documentation: copies of original records, legal documents, or published records (title, author, publication date, number, and page of volume must be given). DAR and SAR applications can be submitted as part of the reference packet to prove lineage, however some older CAR, DAR and SAR Patriot lines have been closed, while others require updating with new references, and with additional dates and places before they can be considered in verifying an application. Applicants presenting a NSDAR application need only to furnish the name and number on the DAR application. Applicants presenting a NSSAR application need to furnish a Record Copy of the SAR application.

Primary documentation: For those generations who lived subsequent to 1850, vital records (birth, marriage and death certificates) and the Federal Census records are especially helpful. For generations who lived prior to 1850, sources such as probate records, land records and church records are most commonly used. Genealogies and county histories must cite the exact sources used for the information they contain.
