

Free Reading Assessment Options

- * Choose a short story scene/excerpt/ or essay to emulate; provide a copy of the excerpt emulated from the piece you read. (excerpts may be 1-2 pages of short story)
- * Choose a short story scene/excerpt/ or essay to modernize or update (different time setting) or different physical location for the setting; provide a copy of the excerpt emulated from the piece or poems you read. (excerpts may be 1-2 pages of short story)
- * Tell the story from a different point of view or different character perspective; provide a copy of the excerpt emulated from the piece or poems you read.
- * Write a collection of poems (total of three) on a similar theme and emulate the poet; provide a copies of the poems emulated from those you read. For longer poems, you only need to emulate two.
- * Create a “Facebook” page in PowerPoint for your short story excerpt/essay excerpt/poem that includes the following:
 - ☞ Short author bio
 - ☞ Your reaction to the piece (like a blog entry)
 - ☞ 3-5 sentences emulating the author’s style or one poem
 - ☞ A brief summary of the piece you read
 - ☞ Pictures/media/music relating to the piece/author/etc
