

Marriages and Children of Hannah Falkinburg

At present, my records for Hannah Falkinburg show the following:

Early Church Records of Burlington County, New Jersey, Volume 1 By
Charlotte D. Meldrum p 139 & 140 show Richard geting permission to marry
and the transfer of membership of his wife Hannah from Evesham Meeting.
Hannah Falkenbug was not a member of Evesham Meeting. I think the
Survey Association information is wrong, and Hannah married Richard
Southard.

The record I used of Hannah's marriage to **Richard Buffin** comes from the
Minutes of the Friends:

1769, David Antrim and Mary Falkinburgh, and at the same time and
place Richard Buffin and Hannah Falkinburgh, were married. Mary
and Hannah were daughters of Henry Jacobs Falkinburgh, Jr.

My records show the marriage to John Southard earlier in 1767, but the offspring reported have births up to 1814, and John is listed with a date of death in 1858. All of this lends credibility to lindapauline's statement.

When I searched Ancestry Family Trees John Southard/b. 1767/spouse Hannah Falkinburg there were 21 entries. Few had "original data sources". The ones which had census data for 1850/1860 from Vermillion IN showed a **birthplace of Virginia, not New York.**

For this reason I am doubting the validity of the record in my family tree.

The following reference to Richard Buffin/Hannah Falkinburg

These data are consistent with the marriage date of Hannah and Richard (1669) and the birth date I have for Penelope (1774)

The Ancestral File Records on FamilySearch.org indicate that John died in 1856 in Hillsdale, Vermillion IN. That would make him 106 y/o. Also from



the census records the John Southard in Hillsdale IN was born in VA, not Hempstead, NY as indicated in the file.

Penelope (Buffin) Falkinburg (Fortenburg) is reported the Friends Meeting in Upper Springfield. This may be where Samuel and Penelope lived.

8th mo, 8th da, 1792. Job Stockton reported for neglecting meeting and marrying contrary to discipline. Susannah Lishmael reported for marrying first cousin. Tallman Pimmock reported for committing fornication with his first cousin, neglecting meeting, keeping unprofitable company, deviating in dress from the discipline, frequenting places of diversion and following vain amusements. Penelope Fortenburg reported for marrying a man not in membership, he being her first cousin.
