Candidate Keep His Pledge – The Campaign Continues

HOUSTON, Texas – September 9, 2002 - Last week the Libertarian Party state chair, acting on a court order, declared Clifford F. William ineligible to seek the office of Chief Justice Texas Supreme Court. He did so under protest. Mr. William is seeking legal remedies to restore his candidacy. He has pledged that while legal avenues exist to restore his candidacy he will continue to campaign for office.

Saturday, September 7th, Mr. William appeared at a “Meet-the-candidate Luncheon” in College Station, sponsored by the Libertarian Party of Brazos County. After the luncheon he made a radio appearance at KEOS 89.1 FM, Community Radio for the Brazos Valley. Mr. William was scheduled for a 30 minute live program with host Carl Hasan but remained for two hours.
