Camp Philosophy

Bolles Pitching Coach Taylor Cobb, along with Fleming Island High School Hitting Coach Jeremiah Klosterman, will be presenting a one day baseball camp at HABL. Camp instructors will also include several current "State Champion" Bolles high school players, several current Division I players, and special guest hitting instructor David Kelly. The camp will address all facets of the game with a special emphasis on improving the fundamentals necessary to become a more complete player. In addition to detailed instruction on hitting, pitching and defense, campers will also participate in a live batting practice session on the field and scrimmage games to end the day.

Taylor Cobb - Pitching Coach - The Bolles School

Cobb graduated from Bolles in 2001 where he earned all-state honors as well as was named the Florida Times-Union Player of the Year. After graduation, Cobb played collegiately for the University of Central Florida Knights and was then drafted by the Tampa Bay Rays. He is in his third year as pitching coach for the "state champion" bulldogs.

Jeremiah Klosterman - Hitting Coach - Fleming Island High School

Jeremiah Klosterman has been a baseball instructor for the past twelve years. He played his high school baseball for the Bolles Bulldogs where he went to two final fours and earned all-state catcher honors his junior and senior season. He played college baseball for the FSU Seminoles and went to three College World Series. After finishing playing professionally, Jeremiah has been coaching at Fleming Island High School for the past six years.

David Kelly - Hitting Coach - Former hitting coach for the Bolles Bulldogs, 1999 - 2001, now with the Providence Stallions

Under Kelly, the Bulldogs and Stallions have led the area in several offensive categories along with capturing several district titles. Cobb states, "Kelly is the most passionate hitting instructor I've ever worked with".
