



## **Bird Walks around Lincoln Park's North Pond with the Chicago Ornithological Society**

More than 300 kinds of birds have visited Chicago's Lincoln Park, one of the region's best places to see birds. Join experienced bird watchers from the Chicago Ornithological Society on weekly bird walks around North Pond to observe and learn about our feathered neighbors. Each week may bring a different assortment of birds to view.

Dress for the weather and bring binoculars.

The group meets at 7:00am by the Peggy Notebaert Nature Museum at the southeast corner of North Pond (2430 N. Cannon Dr.), usually on the casting pier at the south end of the pond, but sometimes between there and the museum lobby.
