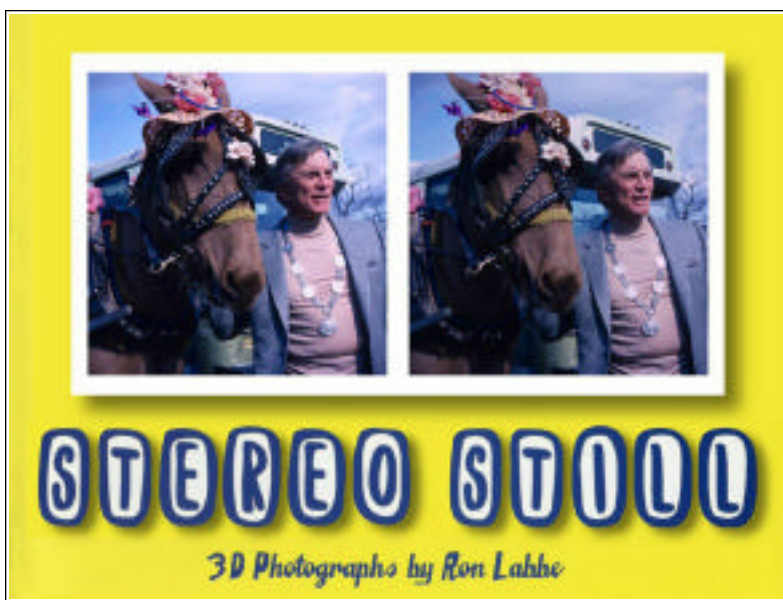

Ron Labbe's.....STEREO STILL LIVE

is "an overview by the artist of dimensional imaging in 3D." Included are images from throughout the **history of stereo imaging**, including a section on various methods of producing the illusion of 3D.



This program was part of Ron's **August 2002 STEREO STILL** gallery show featuring stereoscopic slides at the BRUSH ART GALLERY at **St Lawrence University in Canton, New York.** (In 1991 he produced a show called **TWIN WINDOWS**). The invitation for the show featured a

quote from master photographer **Joel-Peter Witkin**: "I think that what makes a photograph so powerful is the fact that, as opposed to other forms like video or motion pictures, it is about stillness."

, come be surprised! Ron is actively producing 3D videos for **artistic and commercial** purposes. A selection of his 3D video projects will be shown, followed by a question and answer session.

Ron Labbe discovered the secret of stereo photography in 1980 and has been practicing the art ever since. He currently owns and operates **STUDIO 3D** in Maynard, MA, which produces stereo 3D presentations for schools, colleges, museums, corporations and galleries. Directions to Meeting:

From Rt. 128/95: take exit 30A, also known as Marrett Road). This exit will take you to 2A East. The Museum is located approximately 3 miles from this exit. The Museum is located on your left, with a brick entrance and large iron gates.

From Rt. 495 S: Take Rte 128/95 North to exit 30A, and follow directions above.

From Rt. 495 N: Take Rte 93 South to Rte 128/95 South to exit 30A, and follow directions above.

From Rt. 2: Take Waltham Street exit (says "To Lexington Center"). At lights, take a right onto 2A. Museum will be on your left.
