## Directions to Meeting:

**From Rt. 128/95:** take exit 30A, also known as Marrett Road). This exit will take you to 2A East. The Museum is located approximately 3 miles from this exit. The Museum is located on your left, with a brick entrance and large iron gates.

**From Rt. 495 S:** Take Rte 128/95 North to exit 30A, and follow directions above.

**From Rt. 495 N:** Take Rte 93 South to Rte 128/95 South to exit 30A, and follow directions above.

**From Rt. 2:** Take Waltham Street exit (says "To Lexington Center"). At lights, take a right onto 2A. Museum will be on your left.
