HIGHWAY USA (1948)

This show, originally billed as a "half hour holiday", was produced by the **BARBER-GREENE Company** as a tribute to the road builders of America (the company produced road building equipment). Their stereo photographers traveled over 20,000 miles to obtain the choicest highway photos, from which 105 were selected for this presentation. **Paul Harvey**, the famous radio personality, did the narration, which adds old-fashioned punch to the production. The transparencies were originally shot on **5x7" Kodachrome** and shown with a specially built projector at more than 100 locations across the US and Canada. Only recently were the original images scanned for this digital presentation... **Jon Golden** was instrumental in getting the soundtrack transcribed from the original six **RCA Victor 16"** 2-sided mono records.

LIQUID MAGIC (2006)

Photographed and Produced by **John Hart**, Liquid Magic takes what **Harold Edgerton** started and takes it way beyond, into the 3rd dimension! With his specially built beam-splitter camera pair rig, Hart has captured what is likely the most incredible stereo images of liquid interaction ever seen. Sprinkles and splashes dance in space before your eyes, and water droplets turn into stunning glass-like sculpture! Originally programmed in **dual ProShow** slide shows (run from 2 separate computers!), we will see a special over/under single digital movie file (wmv) which retains the beautiful zooms and pans.

WELCOME TO BOISE (2006)

Produced by **David Kesner**, chair of the 2007 ISU/NSA joint convention, this presentation shows why **Boise** is a great place to host the world's largest stereo meeting! We see the city, the hotel, the local sites and even some of the tours that will be featured next July 10-17.

Directions to Meeting:

From Rt. 128/95: Take exit 30A, also known as Marrett Road). This exit will take you to 2A East. The Museum is located approximately 3 miles from this exit. The Museum is located on your left, with a brick entrance and large iron gates.

From Rt. 495 S: Take Rt. 128/95 North to exit 30A, and follow directions above.

From Rt. 495 N: Take Rt. 93 South to Rt. 128/95 South to exit 30A, and follow directions above.

From Rt. 2: Take Waltham Street exit (says "To Lexington Center"). At lights, take a right onto 2A. Museum will be on your left.
