Open Projection: GET THOSE IMAGES READY! We will have a Brackett Fader for projection of Realist-format slides. Please bring your slides to the meeting. Everyone is also encouraged to submit digital stereo images for open projection. These must be double XGA format (each side is 1024 pixels wide x 768 pixels high, parallel preferred). Digital images may also be brought to the meeting on CD if you are familiar with the projection format. Open projection may include 10-15 images per person, subject to available time.

DIRECTIONS

United Parish of Auburndale is located at 64 Hancock Street in Auburndale, Massachusetts.

From Rt. 128 Northbound: Take Exit 22 on Grove Street eastbound. Continue on Grove Street at fork, go left at blinking red light on Woodland Road, UPA is on right.

From Rt. 128 Southbound: Take Exit 24 on Rt. 30 eastbound to 3rd light. Go right on Grove Street; take 3rd right on Woodland Road, UPA is on right.

From Mass Pike Westbound: Take Exit 16 on Rt. 16; take 2nd right after fire house onto Woodland Road. UPA is on right after Grove Street.

From Mass Pike Eastbound: Take Exit 14 to Rt. 128 northbound. From Rt. 128, take Exit 24 onto Rt. 30 eastbound, then take right at 3rd light on Grove Street. Then take 3rd right onto Woodland Road, UPA is on the right.

Enter from the door on Woodland Road, not the front door on Hancock Street.
