In addition to this program, we are hoping to have a few other programs submitted by other members of the club, If you have a short program, please bring it with you. Ten minutes would make a good short show. We will have both digital and traditional equipment. This ISU show will be sent to The Boise Stereo club, and they in turn will sent it to Gmunden, Austria for the International Stereo Conference in November.

Trade Show: Space will be made available for those who wish to sell 3D-related items at the meeting. If you plan to sell items, please let us know in advance of your space requirements.

Everyone is also encouraged to submit digital stereo images for open projection. These must be double XGA format (each side is 1024 pixels wide x 768 pixels high, parallel preferred). Digital images may also be brought to the meeting on CD if you are familiar with the projection format. Open projection may include 10-15 images per person, subject to available time.

DIRECTIONS

United Parish of Auburndale is located at 64 Hancock Street in Auburndale, Massachusetts.

From Rt. 128 Northbound: Take Exit 22, right past Riverside T station, ½ mile more to Woodland Rd at blinking light, turn left, church is on right in first block.

From Rt. 128 Southbound: Take Exit 24, right on Rt 30, go to third stop light, right to bridge over Mass pike, continue on Grove st south, right at blinking red light at Woodland, church is in first block on right.

From Mass Pike Westbound: Take Exit 16 West Newton, to Washington St west, go to 2nd light at firehouse, take 2nd right on Woodland Rd. Go ½ mile, cross Grove St. at blinking light, church is in first block on right.

From Mass Pike Eastbound: Take Exit 14 to Rt 30 East, go to third stop light, right to bridge over Mass pike, continue on Grove st south, right at blinking red light at Woodland, church is in first block on right.

Enter from the door on Woodland Road, not the front door on Hancock Street.
