Rider Education Safety note;

Although most of us will put our bikes away for the winter, there are a few of us fools that will ride all year.

Other than the obvious concerns about snow, ice and freezing rain, there is a concern that many don't think about, "Wind Chill". *Wind chill* is the apparent temperature felt on exposed skin due to the combination of air temperature and wind speed. Except at higher temperatures where wind chill is considered less important, wind chill temperature is always less than air temperature.

The rider traveling at 25 mph will feel the same effect as a 25 mph wind.

The chart below shows the apparent temperature at some common speeds and temperatures.

As you can see that with a temperature of 40 degrees. F at 60 mph the apparent temperature is 25 degrees F. So use this to plan ahead, dress warm and plan rest stops to warm up.

The Goldwing Galley recipe of the month:

Hey Folks, I'm running out of recipes here! If any of you have some good recipes you would like to share, please help me out by sending me one or two. Nancy Caldara submitted this one for us. Thanks Nancy!

Chicken – Cabbage Salad

1 large head green cabbage, shredded
4 green onions, sliced
6 tablespoons sesame seeds, toasted
½ cup sliced almonds
* 2 packages Oriental flavor Ramen noodles, crumbled
4 chicken breasts, cooked and cut in small pieces

Dressing:

1 ½ cup oil
6 tablespoons sugar
1 ½ teaspoons salt
9 tablespoons white vinegar
1 ½ teaspoons pepper
¾ teaspoons sesame oil
* 3 seasoning packets from the ramen noodles

I usually prepare all the ingredients then pour the dressing over the salad just before serving. Mix well!

I usually take this to potlucks and office parties. Enjoy!

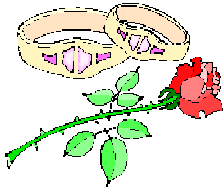

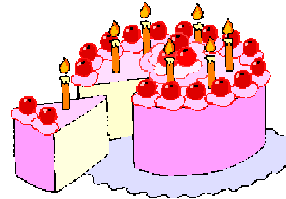
