

# CIRCLE CLOTH



Circle Cloth was inspired by Anne Campbell's [Circle Socks](#). With a little adapting I converted the knitted in the round pattern to a flat knit and changed the stitch counts a bit to make it work with a heavier gauge cotton yarn as opposed to the thin weight sock yarn. (*In my research I found that the original stitch pattern "Hexagon" can be found in Barbara Walker's, [A Treasury of Knitting Patterns](#), Page 67.*)

One skein worsted weight cotton yarn. Examples: Sugar 'n Cream self-stripping or two skeins, contrasting colors (A and B)

With Size 7 (us) needles cast on 46 stitches (I used the long tail cast on method <http://knittingatnoon.com/longtail.html> , therefore the cast on counts as the first knit row.)

*Please note: Always Slip stitches(sl) as if to Purl.*

*wyib = with yarn in back*

*wyif = with yarn in front*

*If using single color just follow pattern disregarding the A & B notation.*

With color A, (1) Purl

(2) Knit

With color B, (3) Knit 4, \*sl 2 wyib, knit 4, repeat from \* across and end with knit 4

(4) Purl 4, \*sl 2 wyif, purl 4, repeat from \* across and end with purl 4

(5) Knit 4, \*sl 2 wyib, knit 4, repeat from \* across and end with knit 4

(6) Purl 4, \*sl 2 wyif, purl 4, repeat from \* across and end with purl 4

(7) Knit 4, \*sl 2 wyib, knit 4, repeat from \* across and end with knit 4

(8) Purl 4, \*sl 2,wyif purl 4, repeat from \* across and end with purl 4

With color A, (9) Knit 4, \*sl 2 wyib, knit 4, repeat from \* across and end with knit 4

(10) Knit

(11) Purl

(12) Knit

With color B, (13) Knit 1, \*sl 2 wyib, knit 4, repeat from \* across and end with knit 1

(14) Purl 1, \*sl2 wyif, purl 4, repeat from \* across and end with purl 1

(15) Knit 1, \*sl 2 wyib, knit 4, repeat from \* across and end with knit 1

(16) Purl 1, \*sl2 wyif, purl 4, repeat from \* across and end with purl 1

(17) Knit 1, \*sl 2 wyib, knit 4, repeat from \* across and end with knit 1

(18) Purl 1, \*sl 2 wyif, purl 4, repeat from \* across and end with purl 1

With colorA, (19) Knit 1, \*sl 2 wyib, knit 4, repeat from \* across and end with knit 1

(20) Knit

(21) Purl

(22) Knit

Repeat the last 20 rows (3-22) 4 times. Bind off.
