Compared to Desert aircraft DA 50 at 5hp, the price on the DA is \$595 and the Evolution is \$599.99, the price is competitive. Both engines need exhaust. Evolution has a proven electronic ignition. Like other gas engines the 58gx would be a great match for any 27% plane. Using a Walbro carburetor the 58gx should be reliable and dead stick free!! Evolution has a line of gas engines that seem to be the most powerful in their class. Here is the line up and prices on each one: 26gt \$399.99, 35gt \$449.99 and 58gx \$599.99!
