## *New from Carl Goldberg* **Yak 54**

This yak is a 77in wing plane and is a ARF it is 72in long. It requires a radio with 8 standard servos. This is possible because there are two servos on each aileron, two on the elevator and one on rudder and one on throttle. For the rudder I would personally use a hi torque servo on the rudder. It will handle a 1.2 - 2.2 two stroke or a 1.2 - 2.4 four stroke or a 2.4 gas. The ARF comes with a fiberglass cowl and fiberglass wheel pants and fiberglass landing gear.
