November 1-7, 2009	Bald eagle on snag North side Mallards group of 10 east side Coopers hawk circling forest near small point	Bufflehead ducks group of 10-15
November 8-14	2 Blue Herons, Belted kingfisher on wire, flew into lake, group of black ducks approx. 24 near small point toward west side, small group of mallards east side, red fox	Common Loon, group of sea ducks-not sure what kind- possibly canvasbacks, Bald eagle, small group of buffleheads
November 15-21	Bald eagle, Belted Kingfisher on wire, group of black ducks, great blue heron, white tailed deer, mallards, Canada Geese approx 24	
November 22-28	Tundra Swans group of 5-10 in central lake, red breasted nuthatch in woods by lake, Bald eagle flying from lake to bay, belted kingfisher diving in lake, black ducks, mallards	Buffleheads group of 20 or more
November 29-December 5	Tundra swans large group, great horned owl heard calling at night from lake, common flicker in woods by lake, usual ducks/herons	some sea ducks possibly canvasbacks large group
December 6-12	Large group Tundra swans (aka whistling swans) 2 turkeys at foot of James Ave near lake, 1 belted kingfisher flying across the lake	Red tailed hawk eating fish on main beach 40-60 swans off pier near south end of Genoa, 100 swans off Melbourne Ave docks 20 swans near bridge bay side, mallards, 2 belted kingfishers on wire by bridge, Bald eagle in oak overlooking bay
December 13-19	Large flock of robins 50-60 in juniper tree near lake eating berries, cardinals, blue jays, flickers in woods by lake, Tundra swans- usual flock, 1 belted kingfisher on wire by bridge Mallards, black ducks	Flotilla of ducks-not sure what kind-past platform
December 20 - 31	Christmas Bird Count - see data

## Lake

Large groups of Tundra Swans from 20 to 100 or more, large groups of American Black ducks, mallard pairs, large groups of Canada Geese. All of these waterfowl are found in all parts of the lake and mingle together. One or two Belted Kingfishers on the wire by the bridge seen flying into the lake and bay shoreline, A group of about 10-12 Eastern Bluebirds near bridge in trees, Cardinals, Redwinged Blackbirds, European starlings, Carolina wrens, Black capped chickadees, Bluejays - 5 or so, Downy woodpecker, Hairy woodpecker, Bald eagle - seen at least once a week along shore and over lake, Turkey and Black Vultures, large group of Robins in trees near lake, Nuthatches, Tufted Titmouse White Throated Sparrows, many other sparrows Red tailed hawk, Red shouldered hawk, Coopers Hawk, Gray Fox on road near James Muskrat east end of lake, many white tailed deer, groups of goldfinches
