Friday, July 25

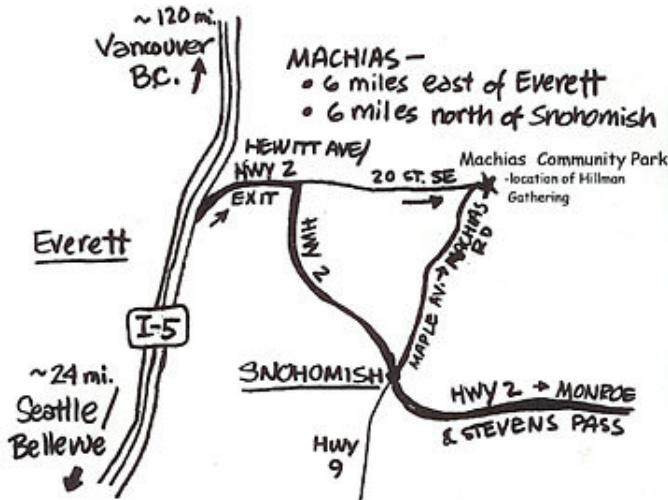
