- Work in the preschool classroom 2-4 days a month, depending upon the class. There is flexibility for pregnancy, work schedules, etc.
- Attend Orientation meetings for the preschool
- Attend a Parent Education meeting one night a month. Topics include all those things you need to learn about your 3-4-5 year old, including temperament, sibling rivalry, child guidance and discipline, & kindergarten readiness
- Hold a board position or parent job to help the preschool run
- Work at a limited number of scheduled "work parties" throughout school year to maintain the school
