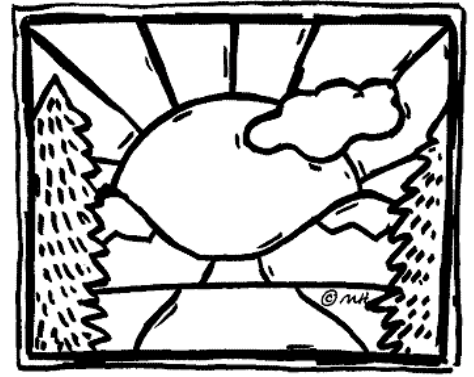

Hello 4B families,
