

How to Order Prints from Flickr.com Images

To order prints of flickr images, you must sign up for a flickr account. Go to <http://www.flickr.com/> and click **Sign Up!** to do so. There is no charge for a basic account. You can have prints sent to you directly or pick them up at your local Target store an hour or so after ordering. The cost is quite low (\$0.15 - \$0.20 per 4 x 6" print as of November 2006).

To order a print, display the desired image on flickr:

Click on "ORDER PRINTS" above the desired image and follow the instructions from there. Repeat the procedure for any other images you want printed.
