PROPOSED CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MIKE DeLUSE AND SHIRLEY PETERS
ROUTE 1E, BOX 229
EDDYVILLE, OREGON 97343

confirms the right to use the waters of LITTLE ELK CREEK, a tributary of YAQUINA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 6.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 44657. The date of priority is OCTOBER 30, 1979. The right is limited to not more than 0.08 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

Portable pumping is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 13, T 11 S, R 9 W, W.M.;
PORTABLE PUMPING BETWEEN POINTS 1430 FEET SOUTH AND 490 FEET EAST & 1950 FEET SOUTH AND 2500 FEET EAST FROM NORTHWEST CORNER SECTION 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 4.9 ACRES
SE 1/4 NW 1/4 1.1 ACRES

TOWNSHIP 11 SOUTH, RANGE 9 WEST, W.M.
