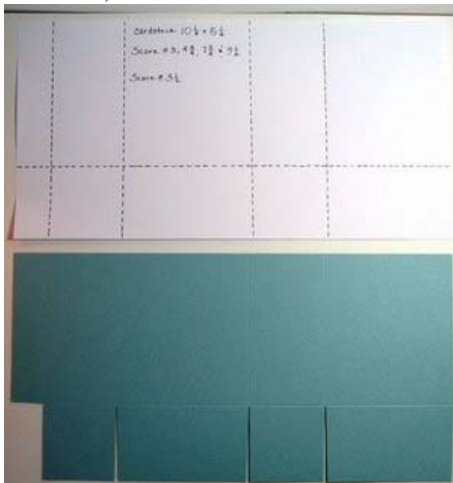
(Please read all directions before starting your project. Many notes are provided to help you!)

Step # Description

- 1 Score the 5 ¼ x 10 ¼ Baja Breeze CS as follows:
 - Lengthwise at 3 ½
 - On the short side at 3, 4 ¾, 7 ¾, and 9 ½

Note: If you are attending the class this has been done for you.

- 2 Cut the sections for the bottom of the box, up to the score line, as shown here.



- 3 Create the backpack flap (2 ½ x 2 15/16 Baja Breeze CS).
 - Score at ½ on the long side.
 - Run the 2 x 2 15/16 DS Paper through the Xyron 510 (The side you want to show is face up).
 - Attach the 2 x 2 15/16 DS Paper to the 2 ½ x 2 15/16 Baja Breeze paper.
 - The ½ portion should not be covered.
 - Using the coluzzle cut the backpack flap on the 6th line from the center (shown at the right).

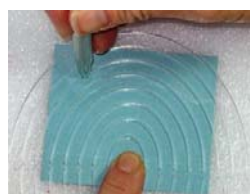

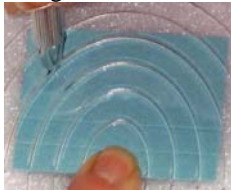


- 4 Punch 1/8" holes in the backpack flap as shown here. Punch a hole on the front of the backpack flap where you would like the flower placed. Attach the paper flower using one silver brad.



- 5 Create the front faux pocket.

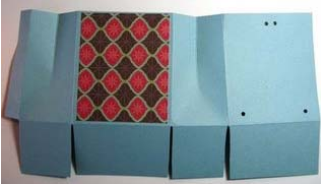
- Layer the 1 1/4 x 1 3/4 DS Paper to the 1 1/4 x 1 3/4 Baja Breeze CS using the Xyron 510.
- Create a rounded edge on each corner using the round corner punch.
- Layer the 1 x 1 3/4 DS Paper to the 1 x 1 3/4 Baja Breeze CS using the Xyron 510 to create the faux pocket flap.
- Using the coluzzle cut the faux pocket flap on the 4th line from the center (shown here).



- Round the top corners with the corner round punch.
- Attach the pocket flap to the faux pocket using snail adhesive.
- Attach the three silver brads as desired on the faux pocket.

- 6 Fold all score lines and gently bend in the sides so the backpack can close.

- 7 Punch 1/8 holes in the one end of the 5 1/4 x 10 1/4 CS. See picture; please note I have not used the large DS paper shown.



- 8 Attach the backpack flap to the 5 1/4 x 10 1/4 CS using sticky strip.

- 9 Then tie on your ribbon. You can use sticky strip to attach the striped ribbon instead of tying it.



- 10 Fold up your backpack and attach with sticky strip.

- 11 Attach the faux pocket with popup glue dots.

- 12 Attach the 1/2 circle Velcro under the backpack flap.
