*** Clear acetate (AKA transparency or report/presentation covers) can be purchased at any office supply store.

*** Any item without a number can no longer be purchased through Stampin’ Up!.

*** NOTE – Snail Adhesive can be replaced by your favorite adhesive such as glue dots, glue lines, etc.

Recipe – Please read all directions before starting your project. Many notes and hints are provided to help you!

Step #	Description
1	Score 5 ½ x 8 ½ Acetate at 4 ¼. Use your fingernail or bone folder to make a crisp crease if necessary. Due to the size of your acetate you may need to trim one side after your score. NOTE: This step is done for you if you are taking the class.
2	Wipe off acetate with a cloth or paper towel to remove fingerprints and/or excess lint if necessary.
3	Using the Cotton White StazOn ink stamp the snowflakes as desired on the card front. *** NOTE: The acetate may be slippery; stamp cautiously! Let the StazOn ink dry for a few minutes.
4	Using the same Cotton White StazOn ink stamp the Christmas Tree Base to the 2 ¾ x 3 ¾ Handsome Hunter CS. Let Dry!
5	Stamp the Christmas Tree Front using Versamark ink and immediately cover with the Winter White embossing powder. Brush off any excess embossing powder.
6	Using the heat tool heat the embossing powder until it appears opaque. If you are unsure if it is done heat a little more.
7	Stamp/Write any Christmas greeting on the 2 7/8 x 3 7/8 Whisper White CS using Handsome Hunter ink.
8	LAYERING: This is the tricky part of making this type of card. All layers need to be done perfectly so it does not show from one side to the next. The following steps will show the order in which I layered my CS. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Layer 3 x 4 Handsome Hunter CS on very back of card using glue dots (don’t put on edges of CS). • Layer stamped 2 7/8 x 3 7/8 Whisper White CS on the inside of the card over the 3 x 4 Handsome Hunter CS. • Layer the second 2 7/8 x 3 7/8 Whisper White CS to the front of the card using glue dots. HINT: When layering this piece have the card closed and layer it directly on the inside piece of Whisper White CS. • Layer the 2 ¾ x 3 ¾ Handsome Hunter CS to the card front using snail adhesive. • Layer the second 3 x 4 Handsome Hunter CS to the inside of the card front using glue dots (don’t put on edges of CS). HINT: Place the CS face up directly on top of the inside message. Your two pieces of Handsome Hunter CS should be lying perfectly so that it appears to be one piece. Close the card gently so you don’t move the CS. All of your layers should be aligned and look as if they are floating when the card is closed.
9	Tie Ribbon around inside of card and knot on front of card.
