



### Recipe

(Please read all directions before starting your project. Many notes are provided to help you!)

- | Step # | Description  |
|--------|--|
| 1      | Fold 4 ¼ x 11 Whisper White CS in half using bone folder to make crease if necessary.  |
| 2      | Using Backpack pattern trace backpack onto fold of the folded Whisper White CS. Cut along the traced line.   |
| 3      | Using the backpack pattern trace the middle piece onto Pacific Point CS scraps. Cut along the traced line. <i>NOTE:</i> I cut this piece shorter than the pattern. This was my preference. |
| 4      | Using the backpack pattern trace the small piece onto Whisper White CS scraps. Cut along the traced line.  |
| 5      | Stamp any design on each piece using Pacific Point ink. If you want a lighter color stamp off once onto scratch paper and then onto your CS.   |
| 6      | Decorate each piece with a white or black gel pen to look like stitching.  |
| 7      | Attach the Pacific Point and Whisper White pieces using popup glue dots to the card front.   |
| 8      | Attach each piece of ribbon on the back of the card to look like bag straps. These can be attached using sticky strip.   |
