

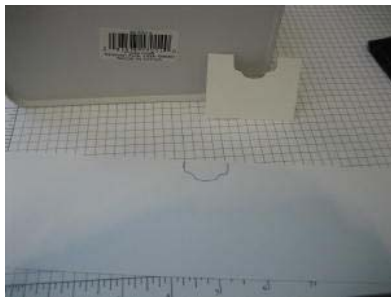


Recipe

(Please read all directions before starting your project. Many notes are provided to help you!)

Step # Description

- 1 Trace the notch cut out onto the back of one of the 3 x 12 DS Papers; cut it out. This notch should be traced along the middle.



You will now have one 3 x 12 paper with the notch and one without.

Measure your notch up to your lunch tin. Trim where needed.

- 2 Use a foam brush to liberally apply Mod Podge directly onto upper 2/3 of the tin front and sides (**NOT the top**).
- 3 Place notched upper-half strip of paper on the tin and press down, smoothing wrinkles and pressing ends down around the sides. Repeat on the back with the second upper-half strip of paper so the ends overlap the front strip of the paper. The paper will overlap on the sides of the tin. **Important:** Make sure you have no bubbles or wrinkles.
- 4 Use foam brush to apply Mod Podge to the lower front portion and the sides of the tin. Place lower-half strip on the Mod Podge area. This should cover the front and part of the sides of the tin. Repeat process on the back portion of the tin. Again, make sure you have no wrinkles or bubbles.
- 5 Use foam brush to apply Mod Podge all over the papered area of the tin. This seals the paper so it will be more durable.
- 6 Mix paint to get the color you want. Paint the top of your tin with a foam brush. Make sure all brushstrokes go in the same direction. Place tin front-side down with the handle lifted up on something so the lid can dry.
- 7 Once lid is dry, use a sanding block or sandpaper to distress the edges and top of the tin as desired. This can also sand off any paint in unwanted areas. Use a paper towel to remove any paint flakes from tin.
- 8 Once you have the desired look on top, apply Mod Podge to seal the paint.
- 9 Embellish your lunch tin as desired. **IMPORTANT: Folks in the class, please use the same embellishments I did as we will be using more from these kits for our next project.**
