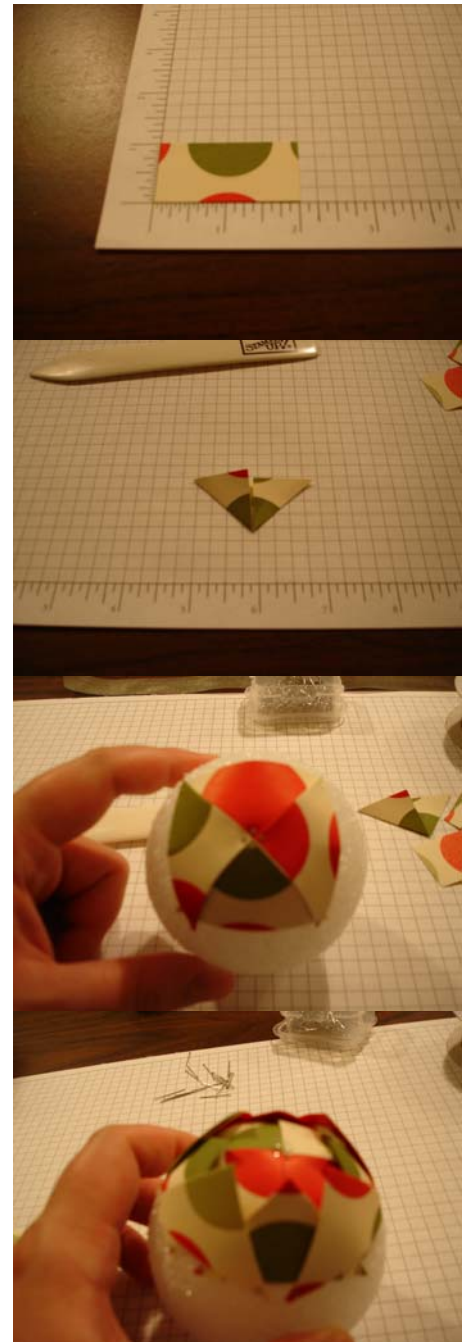

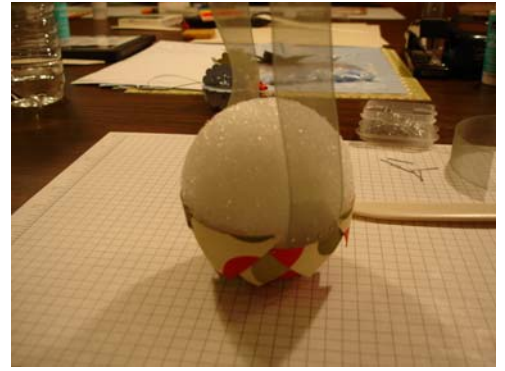

Recipe – Please read all directions before starting your project. Many notes are provided to help you!

Step #	Description
1	Choose your paper. Small prints or loud paper work best.
2	Cut the entire 12 x 12 sheet into 1 x 2 rectangles. TIP: Cut the 12 x 12 paper into 2 x 12 strips. Then cut each of the six strips into 1 x 2 rectangles.
3	Fold each paper to make a point. Both corners will meet in the middle. I folded mine as I went and then started folding about 10 at a time (or as I needed them).
4	Pin down each corner of four folded pieces at the bottom of your ball. On the rest of the pieces you will not pin down the folded point.
5	Add the second row by pinning up the folded point on one of the lines from the first row. Pin down the two ends of the triangle. Don't pin down the folded point. Repeat this step row after row until you have reached the middle of the ball.



- 6 At the halfway point attach ribbon with four pins on either side. The length of your ribbon is up to you. Please measure twice before cutting the ribbon.



- 7 Continue to add paper ensuring the ribbon stays straight. As you near the top of the ball it will become harder to put in the pins. A thimble may be needed. It is also possible that you may run out of paper (or have some left over).
- 8 Tie a bow or add extra ribbon when you reach the top to pretty up the ornament.

Mine is slightly crooked, but for my first try it looks good to me. =)
