Next couple of Jimmy Buffett concerts, on the "Left" coast and Hawaii:

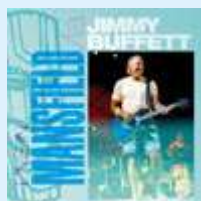
- **Tuesday, January 20 - San Jose, CA at the HP Pavilion**
